Generator Painting - The Board of Directors approved the contract with Muscat Painting to paint the WWTP Generator.

Asphalt Improvement Project - The Board of Directors approved the contract with Kaplan Paving for roadway asphalt replacement and walking path replacements. The areas planned for 2025 include a small section of Oak Hill, a portion of Shoreline Road, and the entrance intersection on Old Barn. 

OUTDOOR POOL

The Outdoor Pool opens for the season on Saturday, May 24th! The Outdoor Pool is open daily from 4:30am - 9:00pm.

- You <u>must</u> have a valid LBS ID card to access the outdoor pool. Those without a LBS ID card will be turned away.
- Guests <u>must</u> be accompanied by LBS residents. Guests may not use a resident's ID card, they will be turned away.
- Children under age 16 <u>must</u> have an adult with them for the entire duration of their time at the pool.
- No food or drinks (other than water) are allowed on the pool deck. You may utilize the patio adjacent to the pool for eating and drinking.
- Guests are permitted to bring 4 guests each time they visit the pool. In addition to the 4 guests you are allocated 10 additional guest passes to be used throughout the year. These can be accessed when you check in with the pool attendant.
- Floats are not permitted at the pool, with the exception of personal floatation devices and "noodle" type floating devices.
- For a complete list of pool rules please see pages 33 36 in the rule book.

The Outdoor Pool is NOT guarded by lifeguards and is SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK.

MARINA AND BEACH

The Marina & Beach open for the season on Saturday, May 24th!
The Marina is staffed Monday - Friday from 12:00pm - 8:00pm and
Saturdays / Sundays / Holidays from 10:00am - 8:00pm

- You may check out a row boat or kayak at the Main Gate between sunrise 12:00pm (weekdays) and sunrise 10:00am (weekends and holidays). You will need your LBS ID card.
- Free Rides are offered on the Pontoon Boat Monday Friday at 1:00pm and 2:00pm and on weekends / holidays at 11:00am, 12:00pm, 1:00pm, and 2:00pm. This schedule may be adjusted on Sundays when a Sailing Race is scheduled. All Sailing Races will be listed on the monthly calendar included in "The Shores Weekly".
- All swimmers must swim in the designated swim area.
- Fishing should only be done from the pier side and is not permitted from the beach side
- No Dogs Allowed at the Beach

INSURANCE CHECKUP

The condominium association insurance coverage renews each year on October 1. This is a good time to review your coverage with your insurance agent to confirm there are no gaps in protection. As an aid in this process, a letter has been prepared by the association's insurance broker for you to provide to your agent.

SPECIAL ASSESSMENT Approved at May 14, 2025 Board of Directors Meeting

Dear Association Member:

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that in accordance with Article IX of the Bylaws, the Board of Directors of Lake Barrington Community Homeowners Association has adopted a **Special Assessment** in the amount of **\$2,500,000.00**. The Special Assessment is for two purposes (1) repayment of the Association's capital reserve account used for the acquisition of the Golf Club; and (2) repayment of a portion of the line of credit used for funding operations for the Golf Club.

Each owner's share of the Special Assessment will be \$1,900.00. The Special Assessment, once adopted, commenced immediately. Owners have two (2) options for paying the Special Assessment:

1) payment of **\$1,900.00** in full on or before June 15, 2025. **YOU WILL NOT RECEIVE AN INVOICE FOR THIS OPTION.** Payments are to be made by check to Lake Barrington Shores, 64 Old Barn Road, Lake Barrington, IL 60010 or

2) finance the Special Assessment through the Association and pay the Special Assessment off in ten (10) installment payments in the amount of \$240.00 on or before July 1, 2025, payment of \$240.00 on or before January 1, 2026, and annually on the 1st of each year thereafter, with the final payment on January 1, 2034.

Owners who do not pay the full amount of the special assessment on or before June 15, 2025, **will be deemed to have chosen the installment payment Option (Option 2 above).** Owners choosing this option will be charged a late fee in the amount of \$100.00 for each installment payment that is not paid within fifteen (15) days of the due date. Installments that are thirty (30) days delinquent shall receive a Notice of Delinquency and the Owner(s)' transponder shall be turned off. Installments that are sixty (60) days delinquent shall be turned over to the Association's counsel for collection.

In addition, in the event an Owner sells or otherwise conveys ownership of the Owner's Unit prior to paying off the full Special Assessment Amount, plus any finance fee for Owners choosing the finance option, then the full Special Assessment Amount (plus any finance fee) shall be due and payable before the sale or other conveyance of the Unit takes place, or in conjunction with the closing of sale.

COMED RATE INCREASE BEGINS JUNE 1ST

LBS/MC2 PROGRAM

Residents at LBS have an opportunity to pay substantially less than the ComEd rate on your monthly ComEd bill. The ComEd rate will increase to 10.2 cents/kWh beginning June 1st.Lake Barrington Shores residents on the LBS/MC2 program will pay a fixed rate of 6.95 cents/kWh (3.25 cents less/kWh than the ComEd rate to compare). Those with ComEd will have significantly higher bills all year (especially during the winter heating months). If your current ComEd bill shows you are with MC2 as the supplier and the rate is 6.95 cents/kWh, you are on the proper program. More than 50% of LBS residents are enrolled in this program.

COMMUNITY SOLAR PROGRAM

We have signed quite a few LBS residents up for the Community Solar Program. This program will offer credits on your ComEd bill (every month). This is another way to lower your ComEd bill. This program—part of the State of Illinois' "Illinois Shines" initiative—supports clean energy by allowing participants to receive credits for electricity generated by solar farms across Northern Illinois. No rooftop panels are required. Once LBS residents sign up, they are placed on a waiting list, then assigned to a solar farm in IL. We have found that people are placed at solar farms (and begin to receive ComEd bill credits) in no particular order. Some LBS residents have been placed a couple months after signing up, some have waited a year to be placed. We have no control over when the ComEd bill credits begin to appear on ComEd bills. However, if you do not sign up for the program, you will never receive the credits on your ComEd bill.

We love our pets in LBS! Every day, you see lots of people walking dogs all over LBS. For dog owners, it's often the highlight of our day.

But remember as pet owners, we all need to comply with the rules related to animals. We see dog owners repeatedly violate these rules, and it is not fair to your fellow neighbors. Follow the rules- - "don't comply and you may get fined."

Here is what all animal owners need to do (these rules are contained in the Lake Barrington Community Homeowners Association Rules and Regulations, Section VIII):

ANIMAL RESTRICTIONS

- 1. All dogs and cats must have a valid registration with Lake County. All dogs and cats must be registered with the Management Office. Unit Owners bringing an animal into the LBS Community must register it within 15 days of ownership.
- 2. At all times animals shall be kept under control on a leash and are not allowed to run free or be a nuisance to other Residents.
- 3. Animal owners have the responsibility for picking up immediately after their animal in all areas and in all seasons.
- 4. Animals are not allowed to be tied up or left unattended outdoors.
- 5. Animals are not permitted in recreation facilities including, but not limited to, the Lodge, pool areas, sport courts, playground, Marina and beach area with the exception of assistance animals.
- 6. It is prohibited to keep or maintain any animal which habitually barks or cries so as to disturb the public peace.
- 7. If a Resident's animal shows aggressive behavior toward another Resident and/or their animal, LBCHA may require the aggressive animal to be muzzled when outdoors. LBCHA reserves the right to request removal from the community of any animal that continues to exhibit aggressive behavior.
- 8. A Unit Owner is responsible for the actions of animals of anyone residing in or visiting his/her unit. The costs of repairing any damage caused by an animal to the common elements shall be charged to
- the Unit Owner responsible and may be subject to fines.
- 9. Please consult Condominium Rules & Regulations for other restrictions.

Also, please remember that dogs are not allowed on the golf course at any time.

If you have any questions, feel free to ask your Condo Board President or contact the LBS office.

Residents who observe animal owners should report violations to the Security office.

Additionally, residents can file a complaint against the offender as set forth in Section XI of the Lake Barrington Community Homeowners Association Rules and Regulations.




