

How Did Sailing & Sailboats Become a Part of Lake Barrington?

You may wonder how our lake became a sailing venue for its residents. Since Lake Barrington Shores began in 1974, there have always been activities centered around the Lake. The Marina was included from the first development and early sales brochures show an aerial shot of the marina along with sailboats, canoes, fishing boats and the pontoon boat.

It started with the LBS logo. The official logo for Lake Barrington Shores depicts a sail in front of a setting sun. The sales brochures for this new development indicated that there were sailboats and sailing lessons. Most early photographs and advertisements show these type boats on the lake.

It turns out that the developers had to make good on those promotional points.

Joe Cragan and Jim Zaremba had become summer workers at the fledging LBS development. One day, they were told a truck would be delivering sailboats to Lake Barrington Shores and

they would have to set them up and be prepared to provide free sailing lessons because that's what it said in the sales brochure. Neither had ever sailed before so you can imagine their surprise. In about two hours, they pulled the boats off the truck and set them up. Joe read the instruction book on how to sail. With book in had he was able to take a boat out and get it back. Within another hour a resident was there for her free sailing lesson.

In the early days, sailing was an individual sport. In 1985, a club was formed to organize races and award prizes and trophies. This club was named the Lake Barrington Shores Sailing Association (LBSSA). Carl Orgell organized the sailing association with Peter Weinert.

Today, the LBS Sailing Association continues the tradition of providing Learn-to-Sail lessons to our residents. If you see a pair of sailors on a sailboat on a Saturday afternoon, you're probably looking at a new sailor graduating from sailing class. And, during the summer, you may see your neighbors participating in a Sailing Regatta on a Sunday afternoon.

LBS MC2 RATE / COMED RATE / VILLAGE OF LAKE BARRINGTON MC2 RATE

The Village of Lake Barrington sent out a letter that everyone in LBS received recently. The Village of Lake Barrington has had a Municipal Aggregation Agreement with MC2 charging 7.25 cents/kWh. Beginning in August, the Village MC2 Rate will exactly match the ComEd rate every month. Everyone who has signed up for the LBS/MC2 program will continue to pay 6.95 cents/kWh (one line item under Supply Charges on your ComEd bill).

The ComEd price to compare is 10.1 cents/kWh. Additionally, there will be a line item called Purchased Electricity Adjustment on the monthly bill with ComEd or the Village Program. This can be up to ½ cent more or ½ cent less every month.

If you are currently with MC2 paying 6.95 cents/kWh, nothing will change. If you are with ComEd currently, or on the Village MC2 Program, the LBS/MC2 Program is the least costly option. Please make sure to check your ComEd bill if you are on autopay and do not actually see your ComEd bill every month.

HOUSEHOLD CHEMICAL WASTE COLLECTION JULY 19

The Solid Waste Agency of Lake County will host a Household Chemical Waste collection event from 8 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. July 19 at Lakes Community High School, 1600 Eagle Way, Lake Villa.

Household Chemical Waste (HCW) is a term used to describe a variety of chemical products found in a household that have toxic or hazardous characteristics. Common HCW products include, but are not limited to, cleaning products, oil based paints/varnishes, flammable liquids, automotive products and garden chemicals.

When disposed of improperly (pouring them down the drain or disposing in the garbage), these products can contaminate the groundwater and harm the environment. Our HCW provides Illinois residents with this opportunity.

The collection is free for all Illinois residents. Appointments are required.

OUTDOOR POOL

The Outdoor Pool is OPEN FOR THE SEASON!
The Outdoor Pool is open daily from 4:30am - 9:00pm.

- You <u>must</u> have a valid LBS ID card to access the outdoor pool. Those without a LBS ID card will be turned away.
- Guests <u>must</u> be accompanied by LBS residents. Guests may not use a resident's ID card, they will be turned away.
- Children under age 16 <u>must</u> have an adult with them for the entire duration of their time at the pool.
- No food or drinks (other than water) are allowed on the pool deck. You may utilize the patio adjacent to the pool for eating and drinking.
- Guests are permitted to bring 4 guests each time they visit the pool. In addition to the 4 guests you are allocated 10 additional guest passes to be used throughout the year. These can be accessed when you check in with the pool attendant.
- Floats are not permitted at the pool, with the exception of personal floatation devices and "noodle" type floating devices.
- For a complete list of pool rules please see pages 33 36 in the rule book.

The Outdoor Pool is NOT guarded by lifeguards and is SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK.

This schedule may be adjusted on Sundays when a Sailing Race is scheduled. All Sailing Races will be listed on the monthly calendar included in "The Shores Weekly".

- Fishing should only be done from the pier side and is not permitted from the beach side
- No Dogs Allowed at the Beach
