

We Love our Lake for so many reasons, don't we? At our recent Summer Concert on the Beach, the Lake Centennial Committee kicked off a campaign to celebrate our beautiful lake, the beating heart of Lake Barrington Shores.

Lake Barrington Shores began as a livestock and grain farm with a meandering 3-mile-long creek. In 1925, this natural basin was impounded with willow tree branches and dirt to create a dam.

During 2025, we celebrate the 100-Year Anniversary of the creation of our lake. The first 18' spillway was built in the 1930's; and the existing dam was built in the late 1940's, raising the lake by 5 feet. Originally named Indian Lake, Robert Bartlett, who owned the property at the time, renamed it Lake Barrington in 1950.

Today, our lake is enjoyed by sailors, anglers, kayakers, canoeists, paddle boarders, swimmers, dog walkers, hikers and pontoon boat passengers as well as others who enjoy the beach and love to gaze at the water.

As part of the Centennial Celebration, articles will be run in the Shores Weekly highlighting the past, present and future of Lake Barrington. If YOU have pictures or a story describing why you Love Our Lake, please submit your entry via email to Jamie Scheppman for inclusion in a future edition of the Shores Weekly.

LBS MC2 RATE / COMED RATE / VILLAGE OF LAKE BARRINGTON MC2 RATE

The Village of Lake Barrington sent out a letter that everyone in LBS received recently. The Village of Lake Barrington has had a Municipal Aggregation Agreement with MC2 charging 7.25 cents/kWh. Beginning in August, the Village MC2 Rate will exactly match the ComEd rate every month. Everyone who has signed up for the LBS/MC2 program will continue to pay 6.95 cents/kWh (one line item under Supply Charges on your ComEd bill).

The ComEd price to compare is 10.1 cents/kWh. Additionally, there will be a line item called Purchased Electricity Adjustment on the monthly bill with ComEd or the Village Program. This can be up to ½ cent more or ½ cent less every month.

If you are currently with MC2 paying 6.95 cents/kWh, nothing will change. If you are with ComEd currently, or on the Village MC2 Program, the LBS/MC2 Program is the least costly option. Please make sure to check your ComEd bill if you are on autopay and do not actually see your ComEd bill every month.

HOUSEHOLD CHEMICAL WASTE COLLECTION JULY 19

The Solid Waste Agency of Lake County will host a Household Chemical Waste collection event from 8 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. July 19 at Lakes Community High School, 1600 Eagle Way, Lake Villa.

Household Chemical Waste (HCW) is a term used to describe a variety of chemical products found in a household that have toxic or hazardous characteristics. Common HCW products include, but are not limited to, cleaning products, oil based paints/varnishes, flammable liquids, automotive products and garden chemicals.

When disposed of improperly (pouring them down the drain or disposing in the garbage), these products can contaminate the groundwater and harm the environment. Our HCW provides Illinois residents with this opportunity.

The collection is free for all Illinois residents. Appointments are required.

OUTDOOR POOL

The Outdoor Pool is OPEN FOR THE SEASON!
The Outdoor Pool is open daily from 4:30am - 9:00pm.

- You <u>must</u> have a valid LBS ID card to access the outdoor pool. Those without a LBS ID card will be turned away.
- Guests <u>must</u> be accompanied by LBS residents. Guests may not use a resident's ID card, they will be turned away.
- Children under age 16 <u>must</u> have an adult with them for the entire duration of their time at the pool.
- No food or drinks (other than water) are allowed on the pool deck. You may utilize the patio adjacent to the pool for eating and drinking.
- Guests are permitted to bring 4 guests each time they visit the pool. In addition to the 4 guests you are allocated 10 additional guest passes to be used throughout the year. These can be accessed when you check in with the pool attendant.
- Floats are not permitted at the pool, with the exception of personal floatation devices and "noodle" type floating devices.
- For a complete list of pool rules please see pages 33 36 in the rule book.

The Outdoor Pool is NOT guarded by lifeguards and is SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK.

MARINA AND BEACH

The Marina & Beach are OPEN FOR THE SEASON!

The Marina is staffed Monday - Friday from 12:00pm - 8:00pm and Saturdays / Sundays / Holidays from 10:00am - 8:00pm

- You may check out a row boat or kayak at the Main Gate between sunrise 12:00pm (weekdays) and sunrise 10:00am (weekends and holidays). You will need your LBS ID card.
- Free Rides are offered on the Pontoon Boat Monday Friday at 1:00pm and 2:00pm and on weekends / holidays at 11:00am, 12:00pm, 1:00pm, and 2:00pm. This schedule may be adjusted on Sundays when a Sailing Race is scheduled. All Sailing Races will be listed on the monthly calendar included in "The Shores Weekly".
- All swimmers must swim in the designated swim area.
- Fishing should only be done from the pier side and is not permitted from the beach side
- No Dogs Allowed at the Beach

Pests

Please see the reminders below:

Pets

There is a leash law in Lake County. Pets shall not be allowed to run loose in the Common Elements. At all times while outdoors, pets shall be kept under control on a leash. Pets shall not be left unattended in the Common Elements at any time.

Insect Control

All interior pest control and exterior pest control, other than ants and bees, is the responsibility of the homeowner. Please visit www.lakebarringtonshores.org and click on Work Order to enter a Work Order Request for EXTERIOR treatment of ants or bees, noting the specific location of the nest.

Rodents

All interior and exterior rodent control is the responsibility of the homeowner, including and not limited to mice, rats, chipmunks and squirrels. If you discover an access point for rodents on the exterior of your building, please visit www.lakebarringtonshores.org and click on Work Order to enter a Work Order Request for maintenance to seal the hole, noting the specific location of the opening.

Animal Inspection Request

Wildlife is part of this community, including and not limited to bats, rabbits, opossums, skunks, raccoons, coyotes and deer. Some of these animals (skunk, opossum, raccoon, squirrel, bat) will chew or burrow or find entry to a building. It is only then, when an animal causes damage to the building, that the association will trap. Please visit www.lakebarringtonshores.org and click on Work Order to enter a Work Order Request for maintenance to inspect, noting the specific location of the damage. If bird feeders are present, whether yours or your neighbors, maintenance will not take steps to remove the animal that the bird feeder potentially attracted until the bird feeder has been removed.
