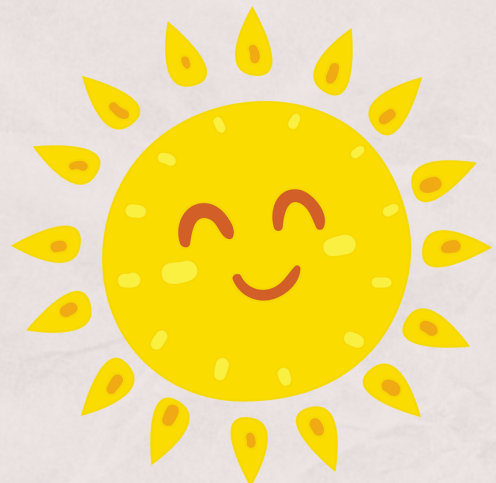

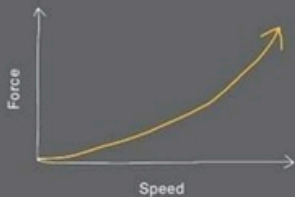

How Speed Kills

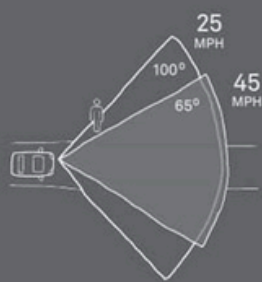

Celebrating 100 years of the lake, Lake Barrington

Creating Lake Barrington

The rolling 510 acres of farmland in southwestern Lake County that is now Lake Barrington Shores was once farmland on which the Miller and Davlin families raised livestock and grew grain.

A creek – fed by water from rains and melted snow – meandered about three miles through this land to the Fox River. In 1925 a member of the Davlin family noticed that the creek and surrounding area formed a natural basin and had the potential of becoming a lake. When he built a dam of willow tree branches and dirt, a lake did indeed form. He called it Indian Lake.

In the 1930s, the land was purchased by C.J. Lord and G.C. Criswell. Criswell then built a concrete dam with a notched opening, creating the spillway on the northwest side of the lake. This dam raised the lake level by five feet. Criswell's initials (G.C.C.), imprinted in the concrete at the time the dam was constructed, are still visible today.

In 1946, realtor Robert Bartlett bought the land and gave the lake a new name: Lake Barrington.

LeRoy Miller, who'd remained to farm the land and raise livestock, began placing boulders around the shoreline, assisted by his daughter, Marianne, and Davlin's grandson, Charlie. These boulders helped to preserve the lake's shoreline and remain in place today.

In 1972, J.S. James Company and Standard Oil Company purchased the land from the Bartlett estate and, in 1973, began building Lake Barrington Shores. The first furnished models were opened in 1974; construction of the rest of the community was completed in the 1990s.

We are fortunate that in developing the property J.S. James emphasized ecological considerations, incorporating Lake Barrington and a 35-acre forest preserve as integral natural features of our community, both of which continue to thrive for enjoyment of all LBS residents.

Future articles will focus on the many ways the lake is an asset for our community – both aesthetically and recreationally – as well as the challenges of preserving and protecting its beauty as a centerpiece of our community.

AC CHECK

What you can do yourself

Before you call a technician to service your system, cross these tasks off your maintenance to-do list.

• **Clean what you can**

Clean or replace any filters inside your system's indoor unit. Also, clear away any dirt, leaves, and debris from your system's outdoor unit.

Pro tip: Keep plants, weeds, shrubs, and other vegetation at least 18 inches away from your outdoor unit to avoid debris buildup.

• **Watch out for leaks**

Check for leaks or holes in your system's ductwork, evaporator coil, or cabinet (the outside "shell" of your unit that holds all the parts inside together).

• **Keep your ears open**

Listen closely for any strange noises when your system starts. If you hear any, call a technician to inspect the problem more closely.

• **Perform a smell test**

Take note of any suspicious or unusual odors when your system starts. If you smell anything strange, call a technician to identify the issue.

• **Keep your vents clear**

Make sure you move any furniture, drapes, rugs, etc. that could be blocking your supply and return vents.

When to call a technician

There are some situations only a professional should handle. Here's when you need to call in an expert.

• **Your energy bills keep rising**

If your utility bills increase but your overall usage remains the same, one or more components of your system may not be working as they should.

• **Your comfort isn't consistent**

If your air conditioner, furnace or other HVAC system can't maintain consistent temperatures, a technician is the best person to investigate the issue.

• **Your unit's fins are damaged**

Bent or damaged fins on your air conditioner or heat pump's outdoor unit can trap heat inside your unit, causing performance and temperature issues.

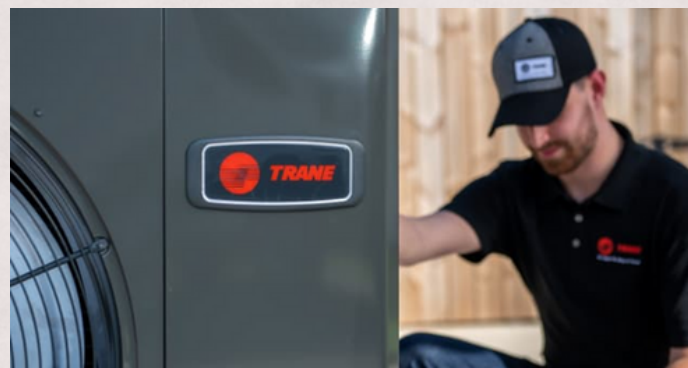
• **Your unit takes on a lot of water**

Excessive water, such as from a flood, can seriously damage your unit's electrical systems. If you suspect that your unit's mechanical equipment might have water damage, do not attempt to resolve the issue yourself. Call a technician. Electrical problems are potentially life-threatening and should only be handled by a professional.

• **You smell electrical burning**

Turn off your unit immediately and call a technician. A burning smell could mean your unit is experiencing a malfunction or electrical issue requiring professional attention.

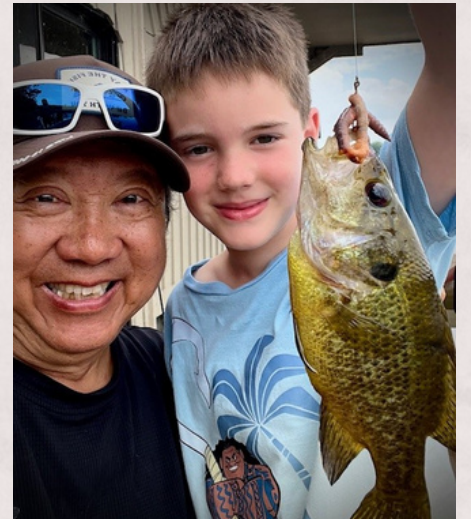
FISHING CLINIC - JULY 9TH

LBS MC2 RATE / COMED RATE / VILLAGE OF LAKE BARRINGTON MC2 RATE

The Village of Lake Barrington sent out a letter that everyone in LBS received recently. The Village of Lake Barrington has had a Municipal Aggregation Agreement with MC2 charging 7.25 cents/kWh. Beginning in August, the Village MC2 Rate will exactly match the ComEd rate every month. Everyone who has signed up for the LBS/MC2 program will continue to pay 6.95 cents/kWh (one line item under Supply Charges on your ComEd bill).

The ComEd price to compare is 10.1 cents/kWh. Additionally, there will be a line item called Purchased Electricity Adjustment on the monthly bill with ComEd or the Village Program. This can be up to ½ cent more or ½ cent less every month.

If you are currently with MC2 paying 6.95 cents/kWh, nothing will change. If you are with ComEd currently, or on the Village MC2 Program, the LBS/MC2 Program is the least costly option. Please make sure to check your ComEd bill if you are on autopay and do not actually see your ComEd bill every month.

HOUSEHOLD CHEMICAL WASTE COLLECTION JULY 19

The Solid Waste Agency of Lake County will host a Household Chemical Waste collection event from 8 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. July 19 at Lakes Community High School, 1600 Eagle Way, Lake Villa.

Household Chemical Waste (HCW) is a term used to describe a variety of chemical products found in a household that have toxic or hazardous characteristics. Common HCW products include, but are not limited to, cleaning products, oil based paints/varnishes, flammable liquids, automotive products and garden chemicals.

When disposed of improperly (pouring them down the drain or disposing in the garbage), these products can contaminate the groundwater and harm the environment. Our HCW provides Illinois residents with this opportunity.

The collection is free for all Illinois residents. Appointments are required.

OUTDOOR POOL

The Outdoor Pool is OPEN FOR THE SEASON!

The Outdoor Pool is open daily from 4:30am - 9:00pm.

- You **must** have a valid LBS ID card to access the outdoor pool. Those without a LBS ID card will be turned away.
- Guests **must** be accompanied by LBS residents. Guests may not use a resident's ID card, they will be turned away.
- Children under age 16 **must** have an adult with them for the entire duration of their time at the pool.
- No food or drinks (other than water) are allowed on the pool deck. You may utilize the patio adjacent to the pool for eating and drinking.
- Guests are permitted to bring 4 guests each time they visit the pool. In addition to the 4 guests you are allocated 10 additional guest passes to be used throughout the year. These can be accessed when you check in with the pool attendant.
- Floats are not permitted at the pool, with the exception of personal floatation devices and "noodle" type floating devices.

The Outdoor Pool is NOT guarded by lifeguards and is SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK.

This schedule may be adjusted on Sundays when a Sailing Race is scheduled. All Sailing Races will be listed on the monthly calendar included in "The Shores Weekly".
- All swimmers must swim in the designated swim area.
- Fishing should only be done from the pier side and is not permitted from the beach side
- No Dogs Allowed at the Beach

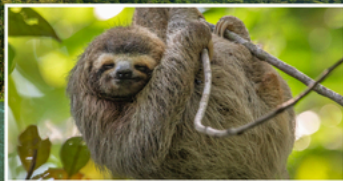

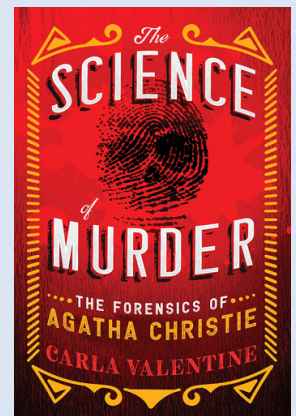

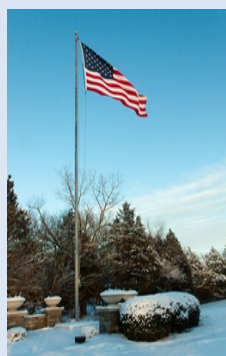
