BUDGET TIME

October and November is the time when each of the 13 Condominium Associations and the Master Association prepare and mail budgets to owners. Each owner will receive either by mail or email a copy of the budget for the master association and the condominium association they live in. The budget for the master association is rolled into the Condominium Association assessment and allocated by your percentage of ownership within the Condominium Association. The Illinois Condominium Property Act which Lake Barrington Shores is governed by, requires that budgets are mailed 25 days in advance of adoption by the Board of Directors.

So how does this budget process work? It starts with the development of the Master Association budget. The Master Association has a Finance Commission which works with the management team. The Finance Commission is comprised of 13 volunteer owners, one from each condominium association, to act as advisories to the Master Association Board of Directors. In addition to the Finance Commission, the management team reviews and develops sections of the budget with their respective 13 member volunteer commissions – Landscape, Lakes and Ponds, Public Works, Insurance, Social and Sports. In total, over 90 volunteer owners participate either in whole or in part in development/review of the master association budget.

Each budget starts with an assessment of expenses including review of potential budget reductions, increases by contract, historical expenses, and increasing cost of goods/services. Since each association is not-for-profit, the assessments are based upon what total expenses are anticipated for the upcoming fiscal year. Each association is required to also assess for reasonable reserves for long term capital projects. For each condominium association, this would mean reserves to aid in funding for elements like roofs, siding, driveways. For the master association, the infrastructure of the community is extensive and includes elements like the water treatment plant, the wastewater treatment plant, storm sewers, roadways, amenities, landscapes, etc.

As you receive both of your budgets (master and condo), please take the time to review. Should you have any questions, please contact the management office, a member of the board, or attend the budget adoption meeting. For the master, you can also watch this short informational video which highlights changes with the 2026 Budget.

LAKE BARRINGTON SHORES FISHING OPPORTUNITIES

Lake Barrington Shores offers residents exclusive fishing opportunities on its private 96-acre lake. Here are the key details:

- Resident-Only Access: Fishing is available to residents and their guests within this gated community.
- Illinois Fishing License: Required for all anglers 16 years or older; not required for those under 16 or individuals declared legally disabled or blind.
- Outstanding Fishery: The lake is best known for largemouth bass, black crappie, bluegill, and warmouth.
- Catch and Release Policy: All game fish (bass and northern pike), regardless of size, must be released to maintain healthy fish populations. Panfish (bluegill, crappie) may be kept.
- Marina and Shore Fishing: Anglers may fish from the shoreline or from boats available at the community marina.
- Supportive Fishing Community: There are periodic fishing events, clubs, and lessons to promote angling skills and social engagement among residents.

These features combine to provide a sustainable, high-quality fishing experience within a well-managed, scenic private lake setting.

Seasonal fishing reports for 2025 at Lake Barrington indicate another strong year for anglers, with several popular game fish species available:

- Bass: Largemouth bass fishing remained very good in 2025, with multiple reports of "big bass" catches. Bass are abundant and healthy, thanks to catch-and-release policies and an ample forage base.
- Crappie: The crappie bite was especially productive this year, with fish in the 10-12 inch range reported—highlighting the lake as "awesome" for crappie anglers.
- Bluegill: Bluegill are plentiful, providing steady action for families and younger anglers. They remain highly accessible from shore and are available throughout the spring and summer.
- Warmouth: This lesser-known panfish is also regularly caught and offers additional variety for anglers targeting mixed-species creels.
- Weed Growth: Seasonal weed growth was noted in reports, so productive fishing often occurs around weed edges and open pockets especially during summer peak. Spring and early summer proved particularly productive, while the bite typically slows a bit in mid-summer due to higher temperatures and weed growth.

Fall generally sees a resurgence in bass and crappie activity as waters cool.







Cantigny History

In advance of the trip, we wanted to give you some interesting history regarding Cantigny Park:

The French village of Cantigny was the site of the first major American offensive in World War I. It was captured by U.S. troops in May 1918, and the subsequent battle was America's first major victory in the war. The win affirmed the value of the US as independent fighting units to both allies and adversaries.



Gardeners of the Shores, Con't.

The 500-acre property we will be visiting was acquired by Joseph Medill, who was a Canadian-American newspaper editor, publisher, and politician. He was co-owner and managing editor of the <u>Chicago Tribune</u>, and <u>Mayor of Chicago</u> from after the <u>Great Chicago Fire</u> of 1871 until 1873. He made the purchase in the late 1800's and it became his country estate, which he called <u>Red Oaks</u>. After Mr. Medill's death, the estate passed to his grandson, Colonel <u>Robert R. McCormick</u>.

McCormick served in <u>World War I</u> and saw action at the <u>Battle of Cantigny</u> in northern France where Colonel McCormick commanded an artillery battalion in 1918 as a member of the U.S. Army's First Division. After returning home, he renamed the estate *Cantigny* in honor of this battle.

Besides serving as a US Army Colonel, he was a lawyer, a Chicago Alderman, and probably best known, as publisher of the Chicago Tribune. He also served as chairman of the <u>American Newspaper Publishers Association</u>'s Committee on Free Speech. Colonel McCormick established the Robert R. McCormick Charitable Trust and designated Cantigny as a public space for education and recreation. It is now a part of the McCormick Foundation.






