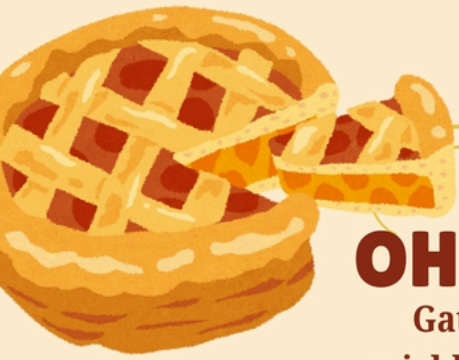

Community Corner

FALL CLEAN UP

Early in the season, and as much as possible throughout the season, contractors are responsible for blowing the leaves out of the beds, mow them up into small pieces and blow them back into the bed where they can act as mulch. At times they will also mow them into fine pieces and leave them on the grass, though never in large quantities. Only when the living landscape can no longer handle more ground up leaves, are they to actually remove them from the property and dump them off site.



This is a best management practice for many beneficial reasons. Small pieces of mulch break down and release nutrients back into the soils being the most critical reason. There are many beneficial insects, butterflies and critters that over winter in this leaf matter. It saves a lot of money in dump fees. And interestingly enough, there are many companies that will take leaf debris, compost it and sell it back to the property they removed the leaves from, at a premium cost. Leaf Mulch is better than any other mulch, (my opinion). It is ill-advised to scrap every single leaf out of the landscape. You are literally throwing money away and it is not good for the root balls to be so exposed all winter.

Leaf removal services for 2025 will continue up to and including Thanksgiving week. It is a weekly service only and is weather dependent. If your normal mowing day was Tuesday, it does not mean your leaf removal will be Tuesday.

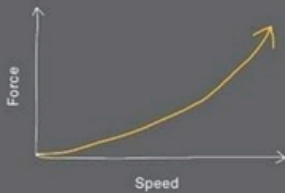

How Speed Kills

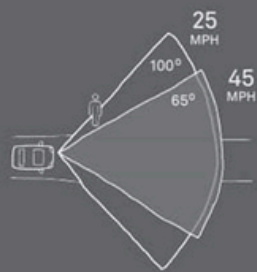

If you do not utilize the gate pass, please be sure to add your guest to the gate list by using ABDi gate access app or website. To avoid backups at the gate, entry will be denied to any visitors not listed. Your visitor will be asked to turn around and contact you to add them to the gate list.

Please be sure to remind your guests of the rules of the road. The speed limit of 20 mph is strictly enforced along with making complete stops at stop signs. 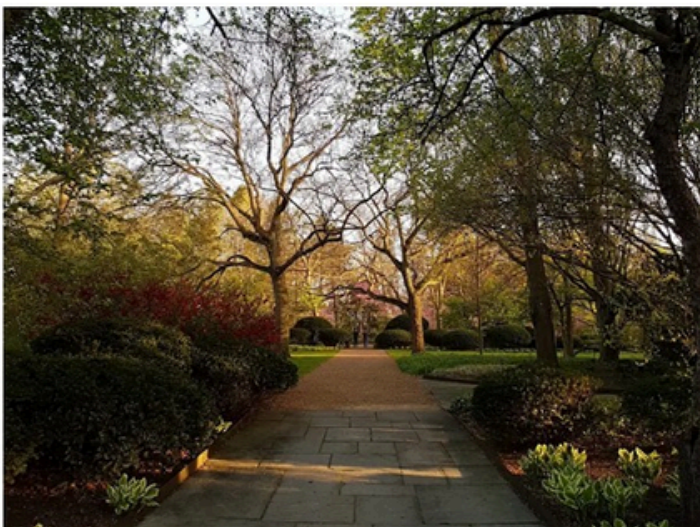
In the next two editions of the Shores Weekly we will continue to provide more Cantigny history and interesting facts for those of you who may want to go on your own and/or those of our residents, as well as attendees, that may still be interested in more of the Cantigny history.

A little about the grounds –

During the early 1930s, Colonel Robert R. McCormick's estate held an experimental farm on site, which served as a working "laboratory" with the goal of serving the family farms that blanketed the countryside. To educate and share the accomplishments of experimental farms, McCormick's Chicago Tribune ran a weekly column entitled "Day by Day Stories of the Experimental Farms," helping to secure the future of the Midwest as a leader in agriculture.

After McCormick's death in 1955, the Board of Directors decided to change Cantigny's focus from agriculture to horticulture by hiring landscape architect Franz Lipp to design and build a world-class garden. In 1967, Lipp began construction of one of the largest display gardens (30 acres) in the Midwest with more than 160,000 annuals, perennials, ground covers and flowering shrubs and trees providing education and inspiration for home gardeners.

McCormick and his first wife, Amy, are buried on the grounds. The graves, located near the mansion, is known as the Exedra and was designed by Chicago architect, Andrew Rebori.

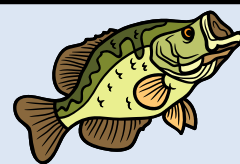

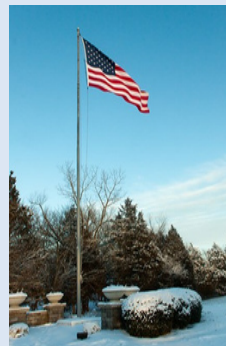
