LA BOHEME.....The Opera


Yes, you're on the right page.....not a movie critique this time.....something different....an OPERA presented by Fathom Events at our local Deer Park Movie theater. Puccini's wonderful love story opera presented on a huge screen coupled with wonderful audio. Every seat is front row/center via skilled professional camerawork at the NYC Metropolitan Opera House....hundreds of close-ups that would be impossible to experience if you're sitting in the 2nd balcony at the Met.

This is a poignant love story with a tragic ending between Rudolfo and Mimi. A male quartet sharing a seedy apartment is the core link through all 3 acts with aria after aria and the glue that holds this love story together. A poet, a painter, an actor plus Rudolfo keep us entertained throughout this epic story. An astonishing top notch orchestra provides the supporting instrumental music for all the scenes that included hundreds of extras. English subtitles are accurate and timely throughout the presentation.

It's a 2+ hour opera that is expanded to almost 3 ½ hours with 2 ten minute intermissions plus interviews and guest performances added to our experience. The price of admission, at the Movie Theater, was only \$13.00 rather than \$150.00 or more for a seat at the Met for a live performance.....BUT...this was a real live performance via Fathom Events for anyone purchasing a ticket. Such convenience coupled with behind the scenes live footage of scene changes as part of your viewing experience.

NYC staged a Musical "RENT" some years ago that used La Boheme as its underlying theme....maybe you saw this show. 

LAKE BARRINGTON SHORES GOLF CLUB, LLC QUARTERLY FINANCIAL REPORT

Below you will find the unaudited quarterly financial summary through September 30, 2025 for the Lake Barrington Shores Golf Club, LLC.

The Golf Club ended September with net revenue of \$44,291 due to outperforming the plan in key areas like membership, number of rounds of golf, food and beverage.

As with any new business, it is expected that there will be an initial larger investment of funds at the front end which is why you will see that part of the plan includes a deficit of \$157,544 with a projected actual deficit of \$123,865. A portion of the \$1,900 special assessment charged earlier this year included funding this planned deficit.

As we enter the winter months and golf operations shut down for the season, continued patronage of the restaurant will be key to carry the operation through the winter months.

LBCHA (MASTER) BOARD MEETING HIGHLIGHTS - NOVEMBER 2025

The Master Board typically meets the 2nd Wednesday each month with a preparation work session on the Saturday prior. Some highlights of this month's meeting(s) are captured below. This does not include all actions or business conducted at the Board meeting(s). For a full listing of all actions taken and details, please refer to the meeting minutes.*

Saturday, November 8, 2025 – the Board of Directors reviewed the business for the upcoming Board of Directors meeting. There were also several hearings held for violations.

2026 Budget

The Board of Directors approved the proposed 2026 Budget with a 2.71% increase and a Cable and Internet fee of \$74.25/ unit. For a high-level overview of the budget preparation and changes for 2026, please view the <u>Budget Preparation Video</u>. Thank you to the Finance Commission and all volunteers who worked to develop the 2026 budget.

2025 Audit Engagement

The Board of Directors approved the 2025 Audit Engagement with the certified public accounting firm of Condo CPA.

Gutter Guards

The Board of Directors approved the first phase of installation of gutter guards. The contract is with Hammerbrush Construction to install gutter guards on buildings in Condo 3 and Condo 6 and one building in Condo 7. These buildings were selected for the first phase of guards due to having cedar shake roofs (which require gutter cleaning from ladder only). The gutters are cleaned prior to installation of the guards.

Charter Clubs

The Board of Directors approved the charters for the LBS Karaoke Club and the LBS Dancing on the Shores Charter Club.

Lake Path & Motorized Vehicles

We'd like to remind residents that **motorized vehicles—including e-bikes and scooters—are prohibited on the lake path**, even if the motor is not in use. On public streets, these vehicles must adhere to the same traffic laws as automobiles. There have been several recent incidents involving e-bikes and scooters failing to stop at intersections. Please ride responsibly and obey all posted signage.

Have your furnace inspected for proper function and the filter replaced.



Make sure you have an emergency contact with a key to your home listed with the association.



Make sure smoke alarms and carbon monoxide detectors are installed and working on every floor of your home.



Check batteries on your thermostat, smoke alarms, carbon monoxide detectors, and sump pump battery backup.



Have your fireplace and chimney inspected and cleaned prior to use for the season.



Keep garage doors closed.

Attached garages can have

water pipes in them. Plus this will also stop cold air from entering home.



Weatherproof your outdoor plumbing. Shut off the supply of water to outdoor spigots and drain them. Rollup your sprinkler hose & store it for the winter.



Block drafts using weather stripping, window film and caulk to control heat loss around windows, doors and baseboards.



Winterize your home when you

leave for extended periods.

- Keep temp at 55°
- Turn off water at main and drain lines by opening up faucets
- Flush toilets and add antifreeze



In extreme cold, open kitchen and bathroom cabinet doors to circulate warm air. Have your faucets trickle water. If you have a pipe burst, shut off water at main and contact a plumber and the association.

2025 FALL MULCH APPLICATION

Lake Barrington Shores has extensive planting beds, making it challenging to apply mulch to all of them every year. Many years ago, it was decided that the property would be divided into three sections, West, Central and East, and one section would get mulch each year. Believe it or not, each section requires nearly 2,000 cubic yards of mulch to complete the beds and the tree rings in that section.

This fall, the beds and the tree rings in the East section will be mulched, Condos 1, 2, 3 and 4. McGinty Brothers has been blowing mulch into our beds for 3 years running and will be applying the mulch again this year.

McGinty will begin Monday November 24, 2025. Their trucks are large and make a considerable amount of noise. Since McGinty knows their way around, it should go smoothly, but please be careful when you see their trucks. The entire process may take several weeks and this should be the last big landscape invasion of the year.

StarStewardship of the lake at Lake Barrington Shores in Illinois poses several environmental, technical, and community-based challenges, particularly around water quality, invasive species, nutrient management, and the need for public engagement and sustainable planning.

Water Quality and Contaminants - Efforts to maintain and improve water quality are complicated by the possibility of contamination from urban runoff, residential use of pesticides and herbicides, and other sources, such as discharge from drilling or metal factories. Periodic evaluations are needed to monitor levels of contaminants like barium, manganese, and potential bacterial agents (e.g., E. coli), requiring regular assessments and compliance with state and federal standards.

Invasive Species Management - Controlling non-native invasive species, such as buckthorn, and restoring native habitats is a major challenge. Initiatives undertaken locally, like the "Healthy Hedges" program, highlight the importance of ongoing vegetation management to maintain ecological balance and improve water and shoreline health.

Nutrient Loading and Runoff - Stormwater runoff and leaves accumulating on streets add phosphorus to the waterways, leading to nutrient pollution. Excess nutrients can degrade lake ecosystems, causing issues like algal blooms and reduced water clarity, and require collaborative land management and infrastructure improvements

Shoreline Erosion and Habitat Restoration - Sediment accumulation from eroded shorelines and streambanks affects lake health, and comprehensive bioengineering and habitat restoration are necessary to slow erosion and improve aquatic environments. Restoring native riparian buffers is a widely recommended strategy but requires sustained investment and labor

Collaboration and Public Engagement - Effective lake stewardship depends on coordination among various stakeholders—residents, homeowners' associations, municipal authorities, and environmental groups. Education is crucial for fostering appreciation, encouraging responsible practices, and ensuring long-term support for stewardship goals.

Regulatory Compliance and Monitoring - Meeting regulatory standards for water safety and conducting regular monitoring are ongoing challenges. Lack of coordination and adequate resources can hamper timely detection and remediation of environmental issues.

Stewardship of Lake Barrington Shores requires addressing water quality, invasive species, runoff, erosion, and collaborative engagement, underscoring the need for sustained, multifaceted efforts that involve both technical solutions and active community participation.

Lake Barrington Shores is managed by the Lake Barrington Community Homeowners Association (HOA), which oversees the community's amenities, including the lake. The HOA works with professional management companies, such as FirstService Residential, to ensure the lake and surrounding areas are properly maintained. Additionally, specialized services like Davey Resource Group have been contracted to manage natural areas and invasive species around the lake, and EAM maintains quality standards with treatments and approvals, as required for the Lake and Ponds.

First Division Museum




Yes, the Cantigny grounds include a War Museum! During World War I, McCormick served with

the First Division of the United States Army—also known as the "Big Red One". McCormick provided an endowment for the First Division Museum, which was designed by architect Andrew Rebori. The museum has exhibits and artifacts chronicling the First Division's service history, not only in



Morld War I, but also in World War II, and later U.S. wars.

On display outside the museum is the area's largest collection of tanks and artillery pieces, known as "Tank Park". The collection includes tanks and armored vehicles from the First World War up to the present day. Visitors are allowed to climb

And finally, yes, there is also a Golf Club and Golf Academy. Since LBS has so many golf enthusiasts, we thought we should give you some information about the Cantigny Golf Club. It is owned by the Chicago-based Robert R. McCormick Foundation, managed by Kemper Sports (Northbrook, Ill.), and has celebrated 36 years. When it opened in 1989, Golf Digest named Cantigny the "Best New Public Course in America".

Cantigny is the five-time host of the Illinois State Amateur Championship along with frequent regional tournaments. The 300-acre Cantigny Golf complex includes 27 holes designed by Roger Packard, the year-round Cantigny Golf Academy, the 9-hole Cantigny Youth Links and a clubhouse with dining and banquet facilities.
