

### Natural Landscape Preservation Efforts Applied At Lake Barrington Shores

Natural landscape preservation efforts generally focus on protecting and maintaining the integrity, biodiversity, and ecological functions of land areas, often through coordinated management and collaboration across various land types and stakeholders. Key elements of these efforts include:

- Habitat and Biodiversity Protection: Efforts aim to preserve native plants and wildlife by maintaining connected habitats, which supports at-risk or endangered species and overall ecosystem health. For example, removal of invasive vegetation and restoration of native plant communities help sustain these ecosystems long-term.
- Collaborative Landscape Conservation: This approach transcends individual property boundaries, involving multiple stakeholders such as public agencies, private landowners, indigenous groups, and local communities. It focuses on managing landscapes as whole systems rather than isolated parcels, enhancing ecological connectivity and resilience.
- Environmental Benefits: Conserved landscapes contribute to clean air and water, climate resilience (carbon storage and microclimate stabilization), and natural hazard mitigation like flood control through natural vegetation and soil management.
- Community and Cultural Engagement: Successful preservation integrates Indigenous and local community stewardship, educational initiatives, and sustainable economic development approaches, fostering long-term support and respect for natural areas.
- Landscape Restoration: In addition to preservation, restoration efforts such as reforestation, habitat rehabilitation, and rewilding work to return degraded areas to a healthy ecological state, sometimes combining natural recovery with human-assisted activities like agroforestry.

These principles guide many current conservation projects nationally and internationally, including those on private and public lands, ensuring the preservation of natural landscapes for ecological health, cultural value, and recreational use. Specifically, in residential or community developments like Lake Barrington Shores, such efforts would likely manifest as protection of adjacent forest preserves, maintaining natural lake shorelines, habitat buffers, control of invasive species, and trail management to minimize ecological disturbance while providing residents access to nature and wildlife.

### BE CAREFUL WHEN ORDERING NEW WINDOWS!

The bargain windows you see advertised on TV or from big-box salespeople may not be acceptable here in LBS. Some of those replace only the glass panels and sliders, while leaving the inside and outside frames as is. We require the complete replacement of the entire window, frames, flanges, insulation and flashing. This must usually be done from the outside, after removing the trim and replacing it after the Village inspection.

The salesman may call what they're proposing "replacement windows," and the price is sure to be well below what a full replacement would be. But, they won't address any structural or leakage problems that exist under the frames and infrastructure. They are really just a cosmetic fix, not a complete new window system.

For your protection, LBS requires the full replacement because, with the age of our buildings, there is every possibility that wood rot is occurring around the existing windows and patio doors. Just replacing new sliders on top of that won't fix the underlying problems. New insulation around the frames will help your heating bills, too.

Please make sure your contractor has read the Windows and Patio Doors document, and has had their installer (the person who will actually do the work, not the salesperson) sign the contractor information form on which they guarantee to follow the required LBS guidelines.



### **BUDGET TIME**

October and November is the time when each of the 13 Condominium Associations and the Master Association prepare and mail budgets to owners. Each owner will receive either by mail or email a copy of the budget for the master association and the condominium association they live in. The budget for the master association is rolled into the Condominium Association assessment and allocated by your percentage of ownership within the Condominium Association. The Illinois Condominium Property Act which Lake Barrington Shores is governed by, requires that budgets are mailed 25 days in advance of adoption by the Board of Directors.

So how does this budget process work? It starts with the development of the Master Association budget. The Master Association has a Finance Commission which works with the management team. The Finance Commission is comprised of 13 volunteer owners, one from each condominium association, to act as advisories to the Master Association Board of Directors. In addition to the Finance Commission, the management team reviews and develops sections of the budget with their respective 13 member volunteer commissions – Landscape, Lakes and Ponds, Public Works, Insurance, Social and Sports. In total, over 90 volunteer owners participate either in whole or in part in development/review of the master association budget.

Each budget starts with an assessment of expenses including review of potential budget reductions, increases by contract, historical expenses, and increasing cost of goods/services. Since each association is not-for-profit, the assessments are based upon what total expenses are anticipated for the upcoming fiscal year. Each association is required to also assess for reasonable reserves for long term capital projects. For each condominium association, this would mean reserves to aid in funding for elements like roofs, siding, driveways. For the master association, the infrastructure of the community is extensive and includes elements like the water treatment plant, the wastewater treatment plant, storm sewers, roadways, amenities, landscapes, etc.

As you receive both of your budgets (master and condo), please take the time to review. Should you have any questions, please contact the management office, a member of the board, or attend the budget adoption meeting. For the master, you can also watch this short informational video which highlights changes with the 2026 Budget.

### More Cantigny History and Interesting Facts

Even though this event is sold out through GotS, many of you may want to go on your own and we felt that many of our residents, as well as attendees, may still be interested in more of the Cantigny history. First, we should mention that the correct pronunciation of Cantigny is CAN-TEE-NEE. Since it is a French name the "g" is not pronounced; however, some prefer to "Americanize" the name and sound out the "g" making it CAN-TIG-NEE.

### A Link to History

As controlling owner of the Chicago Tribune, Joseph Medill wielded great power in Chicago. When the Chicago Tribune offices, and most of downtown Chicago, were obliterated in Chicago's Great Fire of 1871, Medill borrowed a printing press. The next morning's edition boasted: "Cheer up... Chicago shall rise again!"

### The Robert R. McCormick House -

In 1896–1897, Joseph Medill, the uncle of Robert McCormick and original owner of the estate, built a 35-room mansion on the estate designed by architect Charles Allen Coolidge. It underwent renovation and restoration, completed in 2023, and today is the Robert R. McCormick House.



As part of our visit, we will tour the first floor of the mansion. Among the noteworthy rooms are Freedom Hall, Art Deco style hidden service bar, the Drawing Room and Dining Room. These rooms feature original McCormick-era artifacts, including paintings, swords, library books and wallpaper.




