LBCHA (MASTER) BOARD MEETING HIGHLIGHTS – JANUARY 2026

Highlights from the January 2026 Master Board meeting are summarized below. These highlights do not include all actions taken. For full meeting details, please refer to the official meeting minutes.*

Saturday, January 10 – The Board held its preparation work session on Saturday, January 10, reviewing business for the upcoming meeting and conducting several violation hearings.

Line of Credit

The Board renewed the association's \$2,000,000 line of credit as part of its ongoing financial management plan.

2024 Draft Audit

The Board approved the draft 2024 Audit. Once the auditing firm issues the final version, it will be posted on the Connect Resident Portal for owners.

2025 Audit

Due to delays in finalizing the 2024 Audit, and following the Finance Commission's recommendation, the Board approved transitioning to Cukierski & Associates for audit services under a four-year agreement.

ICE Visit Response Plan

The ICE (Immigration and Customs Enforcement) Visit Response Plan, developed last fall, is now available for owners to review on the Connect Resident Portal.

Landscape Maintenance

Due to ongoing service issues and based on the Landscape Commission's recommendation, the Board of Directors has approved moving landscape maintenance service for Condos 7-13 to Beary Landscaping. This service change is for the 2026 season.

Platform Heater

The Board approved replacing one of the eight platform tennis heaters. The unit being replaced is currently non-functional and cannot be repaired.

Public Safety Reminder: E-bikes and Scooters

Lake Path & Motorized Vehicles

On the roadway, these vehicles must adhere to the same traffic laws as automobiles. We have seen incidents involving e-bikes and scooters failing to stop at intersections. For everyone's safety, please ride responsibly and obey all posted signage.

Winter Maintenance & Safety Tips

Have your furnace inspected for proper function and the filter replaced.



Make sure you have an emergency contact with a key to your home listed with the association.



Make sure smoke alarms and carbon monoxide detectors are installed and working on every floor of your home.



Check batteries on your thermostat, smoke alarms, carbon monoxide detectors, and sump pump battery backup.



Have your fireplace and chimney inspected and cleaned prior to use for the season.



Keep garage doors closed. Attached garages can have water pipes in them. Plus this will also stop cold air from entering home.



Weatherproof your outdoor plumbing. Shut off the supply of water to outdoor spigots and drain them. Rollup your sprinkler hose & store it for the winter.



Block drafts using weather stripping, window film and caulk to control heat loss around windows, doors and baseboards.



Winterize your home when you leave for extended periods.

- Keep temp at 55°
- Turn off water at main and drain lines by opening up faucets
- Flush toilets and add antifreeze



In extreme cold, open kitchen and bathroom cabinet doors to circulate warm air. Have your faucets trickle water. If you have a pipe burst, shut off water at main and contact a plumber and the association.






CHARTER CLUB UPDATES

A recent study published in the journal *Science* updated the status of butterfly populations in the contiguous United States. Researchers found a 22% loss of butterflies in the country including 128 species found in the Chicagoland area like the Northern Crescent, Silvery Blue, and American Lady. Experts attribute the decline to habitat loss, climate change, and pesticide use. A class of pesticides called neonicotinoids, banned in Europe since 2018, is especially deadly.

The U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (USFWS) in December 2024 recommended the Monarch butterfly for federal protection under the Endangered Species Act. After hitting an almost record low in 2024, overwintering monarchs in Mexico rebounded significantly in 2025 according to the Mexican government and the World Wildlife Fund. The increase may be attributed to some relief from drought along the migration route of monarchs east of the Rocky Mountains. But the decision to include monarchs on the endangered species list has not yet been made. Public comment on the nomination included a letter to the USFWS from the Golf Course Superintendents Association of America requesting and substantiating that golf courses be excepted from any additional restrictions that might arise if the Monarch is granted endangered species status.

The study also found that North American butterfly species are moving northward in search of more hospitable conditions and encouraged people to create habitat refuges for butterflies and other insects by planting native flowers, shrubs and trees and remember that when you spray something on your plants to keep things from eating them, you are spraying caterpillars too and they are butterflies-to-be.

We are fortunate and grateful to be working with the Gardeners of the Shores to re-invigorate the butterfly garden at the memorial above the marina. Thank you to the volunteers who have worked to remove invasive plants, plan, and raise funds to restore this important garden.
