# Community Corner

## LBCHA (MASTER) BOARD MEETING HIGHLIGHTS FEBRUARY 2026

Highlights from the February 2026 Master Board meeting are summarized below. These highlights do not include all actions taken. For full meeting details, please refer to the official meeting minutes.\*

**Saturday, February 7**– The Board held its preparation work session on Saturday, February 7 reviewing business for the upcoming meeting. At this meeting, in order to lock in expiring pricing, the Board of Directors approved selling the 2017 Toyota Tacoma and authorized Public Works to purchase a replacement vehicle. The replacement vehicle was planned for in the association’s annual budget.

### **Condo 13 Retaining Wall Engineering Services**

The large retaining walls on the south side of White Oak Lane are scheduled for evaluation, repair, or replacement. The engineering firm of Baxter and Woodman was the successful bidder in providing a condition assessment for this project.

### **2026 Roadway Resurfacing and Parking Lot Sealcoating**

The Board of Directors approved the contract with Kaplan paving for the 2026 roadway replacement project. The roads being replaced this year are portions of Oak Hill (Bluff to Valley View) and Shoreline (Miller Entrance to Oak Hill) as well as the Miller Road entrance gate near the Lodge.

### **Clay Tennis Court Maintenance**

The Board of Directors approved a two-year contract with CR Peterson for the annual maintenance required for the clay tennis courts.

### **Public Safety Reminder: E-bikes and Scooters**

#### **Lake Path & Motorized Vehicles**

**On the roadway, these vehicles must adhere to the same traffic laws as automobiles. We have seen incidents involving e-bikes and scooters failing to stop at intersections. For everyone’s safety, please ride responsibly and obey all posted signage.**

**No ebikes or motorized scooters are allowed on the Lake Path.**

## PRESCRIBED BURN NOTIFICATION

**MONDAY FEBRUARY 23, 2026  
FOREST PRESERVE MAIN PATH  
NEAR OLD BARN ENTRY**



On Monday, February 23rd, Bluestem Ecological Services have scheduled a prescribed burn for this small area of the forest preserve. The section they will be working in is approximately 15-20 feet north of the creek bed on the main path. The Conservators have been cutting and stacking Buckthorn in this location all winter and Bluestem should be able to burn all of it in one day. There are many considerations and decisions to be made when scheduling a prescribed burn and when it all comes together, we don't always have early notice. THIS IS WEATHER DEPENDENT AND MAY BE POSTPONED.

DURING THE ACTUAL BURN, THE PATH WILL REMAIN OPEN. YOU MAY BE REDIRECTED AROUND A CERTAIN AREA AT CERTAIN TIMES. THIS IS VERY LOCALIZED AND VERY ACTIVE TASK SO PLEASE PAY ATTENTION TO THE FOLKS THAT ARE WORKING IN THE AREA AND ABIDE BY THEIR REQUESTS.

## ELECTRIC RATE RENEWAL – MARCH 2026

The current electric rate offered through the association's broker / supplier (AUS/MC2) expires in March 2026. The current rate is 6.95 cents per kWh and the **renewal is a fixed rate of 8.75 cents per kWh for 12 months.** While this is an increase of almost 2 cents, it is 9% less than the current ComEd rate of 9.66 per kWh. If you are currently on this plan, you will receive a notice advising you of the new rate. You do not need to do anything to stay with this rate. If you would like to opt out, instructions will be on the notice on how to do so.

### Did you know?

The Illinois Commerce Commission regulates utilities for the state of IL?

Before switching electric suppliers, do your homework as many may entice you with low rates which are variable and will rise. Visit [Plugin Illinois](http://PluginIllinois.com) for more information on suppliers, their rates, and performance ratings.

## GARBAGE BIN STORAGE REMINDER

Garbage and recycle containers must be stored indoors at all times. Most, though not all, Associations within LBS allow the containers to be placed outside either after 6:00 PM or after dusk the night before the scheduled pick-up day. The containers must then be placed back inside your garage on the same day as pick-up. Some Associations do not allow containers to be moved outside the evening before pick-up and you must wait to put them outside until the morning of the scheduled pick-up day. Please review your rule book or contact the management office if you are unsure of your individual Association's rules.

A reminder that homeowners / residents should use the Tampa FL lockbox instead of the Carol Stream lockbox for monthly assessment payments.

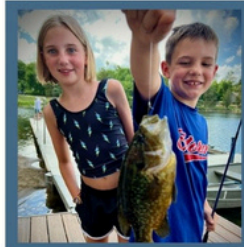
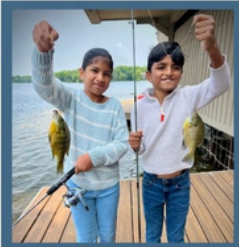

If you are not present on April 9th and your name is pulled you will receive notification on your locker number. If your name is not pulled you will receive your check back.

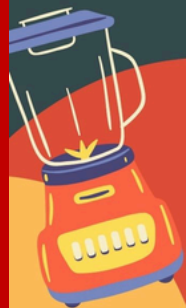

# Winter Maintenance & Safety Tips



*Lake Barrington Shores* <sup>SM</sup>



Have your furnace inspected for proper function and the filter replaced.



Make sure you have an emergency contact with a key to your home listed with the association.



Make sure smoke alarms and carbon monoxide detectors are installed and working on every floor of your home.



Check batteries on your thermostat, smoke alarms, carbon monoxide detectors, and sump pump battery backup.



Have your fireplace and chimney inspected and cleaned prior to use for the season.



Keep garage doors closed. Attached garages can have water pipes in them. Plus this will also stop cold air from entering home.



Weatherproof your outdoor plumbing. Shut off the supply of water to outdoor spigots and drain them. Rollup your sprinkler hose & store it for the winter.



Block drafts using weather stripping, window film and caulk to control heat loss around windows, doors and baseboards.



Winterize your home when you leave for extended periods.

- Keep temp at 55°
- Turn off water at main and drain lines by opening up faucets
- Flush toilets and add antifreeze



In extreme cold, open kitchen and bathroom cabinet doors to circulate warm air. Have your faucets trickle water. If you have a pipe burst, shut off water at main and contact a plumber and the association.

# Butterfly Garden Corner

## February Update and Progress Report:

The Helen Horton Memorial Butterfly Garden Plans for a beautifully reimagined butterfly garden will come to life this spring and summer. The garden will be located on the pathway to the viewing platform over the marina. A schematic drawing of the butterfly garden can be viewed on the lower level of the Lodge, by the coffee bar.



Schmechtig Landscapes has generously donated their expertise to the garden's development. The plan for the butterfly garden will coordinate with the adjacent Veteran's Garden which Schmechtig is also designing. Richard Grant, landscape architect and Director of Design for Schmechtig Landscapes envisions the use of 11 species of plants.

He suggested that the garden include plants that are drought tolerant, mostly deer proof and include the use of both annuals and perennials. Perennials include butterfly bush, calamint, allium, coreopsis, coneflower, monarda, baptisia, daisies, butterfly weed and ornamental grass. Thyme will weave between stepping stones. All of these plants attract and sustain butterfly populations. The plans also incorporate a nearby red oak where hydrangeas will be located. Various annuals will add prolonged color.

We are grateful for the many people who have generously given of their time, expertise and financial contributions to realize this project, including Richard Grant and Schmechtig Landscapes; Julie and James Tortorelli; Lynn Charpentier; Shelly Sutton; Trish Thomas; Nancy Jarvis; Carolin Belden, Marsha Fitzgibbons, and, Len Zolna, whose ongoing financial support is much valued. Additionally, we thank Bob Kerr who will create and donate a steel butterfly sculpture.

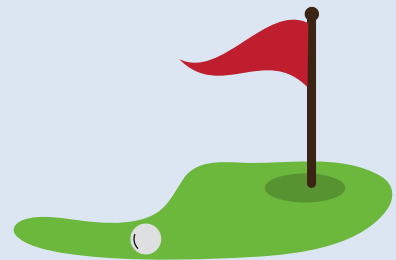

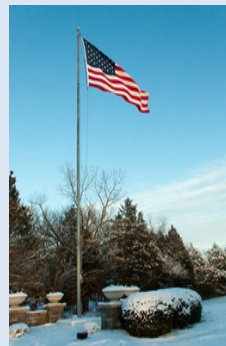


