## ELECTRIC RATE RENEWAL – MARCH 2026

The current electric rate offered through the association's broker / supplier (AUS/MC2) expires in March 2026. The current rate is 6.95 cents per kWh and the **renewal is a fixed rate of 8.75 cents per kWh for 12 months**. While this is an increase of almost 2 cents, it is 9% less than the current ComEd rate of 9.66 per kWh. If you are currently on this plan, you will receive a notice advising you of the new rate. You do not need to do anything to stay with this rate. If you would like to opt out, instructions will be on the notice on how to do so.

After the renewal is complete, there will be an opportunity for any owners not on the program to sign up.



### Did you know?

The Illinois Commerce Commission regulates utilities for the state of IL?

Before switching electric suppliers, do your homework as many may entice you with low rates which are variable and will rise. Visit [Plugin Illinois](#) for more information on suppliers, their rates, and performance ratings.

## GARBAGE BIN STORAGE REMINDER:

Garbage and recycle containers must be stored indoors at all times. Most, though not all, Associations within LBS allow the containers to be placed outside either after 6:00 PM or after dusk the night before the scheduled pick-up day. The containers must then be placed back inside your garage on the same day as pick-up. Some Associations do not allow containers to be moved outside the evening before pick-up and you must wait to put them outside until the morning of the scheduled pick-up day. Please review your rule book or contact the management office if you are unsure of your individual Association's rules.

### 3 Tips and a Quote

After that ridiculously cold blast we had last week here are a few reminders and tips to keep you warmer.

**Your Fireplace** - Who doesn't love a fire in a wood burning fireplace on a cold cold night. By now we all know that fireplaces are inefficient heaters. Warm air gets sucked from other rooms right up the chimney to the outside. Reduce this by installing glass doors which will significantly reduce this loss. But you are still dealing with creosote buildup, potential for fires, buying and storing wood, ashing, etc. If you are burning wood, your fireplace should be checked every year prior to season. Another lovely way to get that cozy feel without burning wood is by placing an arrangement of 5-8 candles, either real or battery operated on the wood grate. Nice glow.

**Your Windows** - The two glass double sliders in my living and dining area cover most of a wall. I have sheer drapes for window coverings. Even with new windows that are tight there is a significant cooler feel when I walk from my bedroom to the front room in the morning. If I know an extreme cold spell is coming that looks to last 3 or more days I will attach blankets or flannel sheets across them, top down. Doesn't look great but I certainly feel the difference in comfort.

**Hats and Scarfs** - Check out your local second hand stores for scarves and hats. How does this help the environment??? The energy used to produce these items has already been expended. You are reusing. I recently scored a beautiful hat and long scarf totaling under 5.00! You may as well check out the sweater while there. I didn't need any but noticed a couple I liked in perfect shape! You can donate your own no longer wanted clothing too.

**Birdies** - This is a plug for our little feathered friends. After all they are a part of our environment. Hanging suet blocks is a clean and easy way to help these guys out in the winter cold. I know seed is not allowed and its a mess anyway. Suet is much better. Check Ace or Walmart. Or, Amazon. I buy my suet cakes in bulk online and you can find suet holders there also. It will take awhile for the birds to discover. Keep it filled so they know where they can find food consistently.

# Winter Maintenance & Safety Tips

Have your furnace inspected for proper function and the filter replaced.



Make sure you have an emergency contact with a key to your home listed with the association.



Make sure smoke alarms and carbon monoxide detectors are installed and working on every floor of your home.



Check batteries on your thermostat, smoke alarms, carbon monoxide detectors, and sump pump battery backup.



Have your fireplace and chimney inspected and cleaned prior to use for the season.



Keep garage doors closed. Attached garages can have water pipes in them. Plus this will also stop cold air from entering home.



Weatherproof your outdoor plumbing. Shut off the supply of water to outdoor spigots and drain them. Rollup your sprinkler hose & store it for the winter.



Block drafts using weather stripping, window film and caulk to control heat loss around windows, doors and baseboards.



Winterize your home when you leave for extended periods.

- Keep temp at 55°
- Turn off water at main and drain lines by opening up faucets
- Flush toilets and add antifreeze



In extreme cold, open kitchen and bathroom cabinet doors to circulate warm air. Have your faucets trickle water. If you have a pipe burst, shut off water at main and contact a plumber and the association.

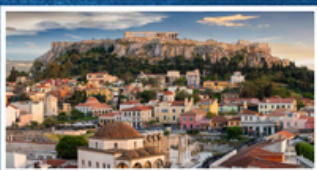

## Butterfly Garden Corner

### February Update and Progress Report:

The Helen Horton Memorial Butterfly Garden Plans for a beautifully reimagined butterfly garden will come to life this spring and summer. The garden will be located on the pathway to the viewing platform over the marina. A schematic drawing of the butterfly garden can be viewed on the lower level of the Lodge, by the coffee bar (a small picture of which is on the next page).

Schmechtig Landscapes has generously donated their expertise to the garden's development. The plan for the butterfly garden will coordinate with the adjacent Veteran's Garden which Schmechtig is also designing. Richard Grant, landscape architect and Director of Design for Schmechtig Landscapes envisions the use of 11 species of plants.

He suggested that the garden include plants that are drought tolerant, mostly deer proof and include the use of both annuals and perennials. Perennials include butterfly bush, calaminth, allium, coreopsis, coneflower, monarda, baptisia, daisies, butterfly weed and ornamental grass. Thyme will weave between stepping stones. All of these plants attract and sustain butterfly populations. The plans also incorporate a nearby red oak where hydrangeas will be located. Various annuals will add prolonged color.

We are grateful for the many people who have generously given of their time, expertise and financial contributions to realize this project, including Richard Grant and Schmechtig Landscapes; Julie and James Tortorelli; Lynn Charpentier; Shelly Sutton; Trish Thomas; Nancy Jarvis; Carolin Belden, Marsha Fitzgibbons, and, Len Zolna, whose ongoing financial support is much valued. Additionally, we thank Bob Kerr who will create and donate a steel butterfly sculpture.

Further financial contributions, whether large or small, personal or corporate are warmly welcomed. They will underwrite the purchase of plants and the installation and ongoing maintenance of the garden. Additionally, we will be screening the award-winning documentary film **The Monarch Ultra**. This short film (54 minutes) explores the parallel stories of the monarch butterfly and relay runners during their 2019 run that traced the migration route of the monarchs. The run covered 2,670 miles, from Peterborough, Ontario Canada to the Sierra Madre Mountains in Mexico. The runners experienced similar challenges as the monarchs face in their annual migration. The film tells the story behind the planning and execution of the Monarch Ultra and how this international relay run connects with environmental activism. The film will be viewed after our regular meeting.

**COME JOIN US - REFRESHMENTS WILL BE SERVED!**



As spring approaches and we begin to think of warm weather, flowers and **BEAUTIFUL BUTTERFLIES** here's some important information to keep in mind when we plan our summer gardens, whether in the ground or in pots! Both insecticides and herbicides can be harmful to monarchs and other pollinators. Systemic insecticides (those we put in the ground) play a role in pollinator declines worldwide.

**PROTECT MONARCHS FROM PESTICIDES** Plants absorb systemic insecticides and as plants grow the toxins are distributed throughout the plant tissue including the leaves and nectar. Monarch caterpillars that feed on the leaves of treated plants are poisoned. Before purchasing plants from nurseries and garden centers be sure to ask whether they have been treated with systemic insecticides, especially neonicotinoids which are toxic to pollinators.
