## SPRING IS HERE ... FINALLY! LANDSCAPERS RETURNING TO LBS!

Officially, landscape service providers return to LBS to start spring clean-up the first week of April. You may have already seen some action in your neck of the woods, but officially, it is next week. Large scale dormant shrub pruning is complete, and now we start having fun cutting down ornamental grasses, clearing out the leaf litter that has been blowing around, and deadheading Hydrangeas and other summer flowering shrubs. Please allow the crews to complete their spring clean-ups undisturbed, as there is a LOT of ground to cover.

## **CURBSIDE YARD WASTE PICK UP BEGINS THE FIRST WEEK IN APRIL, MONDAY'S**

Please place old soil from last year's pots either in a brown yard waste bag or throw it away with your regular trash. **DO NOT THROW IT IN BEDS OR ON THE GROUND. PLEASE BAG THE YARD WASTE YOU ACCUMULATE FROM YOUR COURTYARD IF YOU ARE SPRING CLEANING AND SET IT BY THE CURB.** Or have the landscape company you hired take it away with them, in their truck. **PLEASE DO NOT BLOW IT OUT INTO THE COMMON AREA LANDSCAPE.**

Spring clean-up in the landscape industry is a monumental task, help us help them, so our whole community looks great! Every little bit helps!

# Community Corner

## ELECTRIC RATE RENEWAL – MARCH 2026

The current electric rate offered through the association's broker / supplier (AUS/MC2) expires in March 2026. The current rate is 6.95 cents per kWh and the **renewal is a fixed rate of 8.75 cents per kWh for 12 months.** While this is an increase of almost 2 cents, it is 9% less than the current ComEd rate of 9.66 per kWh. If you are currently on this plan, you will receive a notice advising you of the new rate. You do not need to do anything to stay with this rate. If you would like to opt out, instructions will be on the notice on how to do so.

### Did you know?

The Illinois Commerce Commission regulates utilities for the state of IL? Before switching electric suppliers, do your homework as many may entice you with low rates which are variable and will rise. **Spring is just around the corner, and with any luck, our days of surprise snowfalls are behind us.** As many of you know, winter plowing can cause occasional disruption to turf and landscaping throughout the community. Our maintenance crews have already begun addressing these areas by resetting boulders, removing debris, and resetting existing sod. Please keep in mind that the **Public Works Department is responsible for all snow-related damage repairs**, as outlined in the snowplow contracts. All repairs must be completed **no later than April 30th.**

As temperatures rise and new seed is installed near your home, **a little watering will go a long way** in helping the turf establish and regrow successfully.

## MILAN, ITALY , OLYMPICS - CRITIQUE

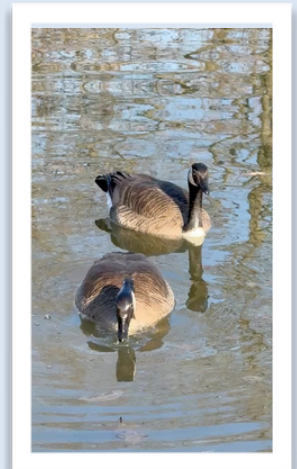


**SPRING is SPRINGING!**

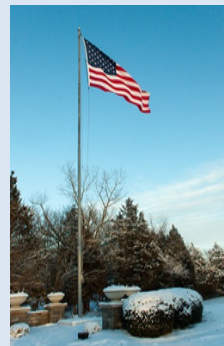



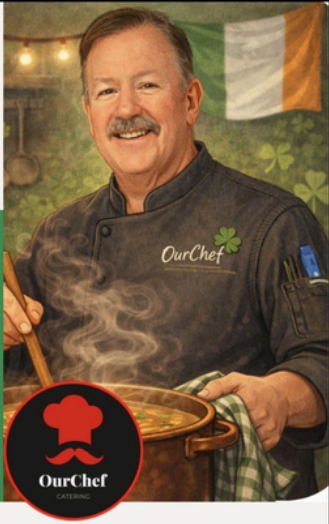
