Lake Barrington Shores Golf Club, LLC Year End Financial Report

Below you will find the unaudited financial summary through December 31, 2025 for the Lake Barrington Shores Golf Club, LLC.

Total gross revenue of \$1.37 million exceeded budget by \$201,611 (17%), driven primarily by higher-than-expected rounds played and strong ancillary spending. The Club recorded 17,981 rounds, outperforming budget by nearly 3,000 rounds, validating pricing, accessibility, and course appeal.

As with any new business, it is expected that there will be initial losses which is why you will see that part of the plan included a deficit of \$157,544. However, we ended the year with an actual deficit of \$110,259 which is a \$47,284 improvement over the budgeted loss. A portion of the \$1,900 special assessment charged in 2025 included funding this planned deficit.

This March we are celebrating the one-year anniversary of the association's ownership of the Lake Barrington Shores Golf Club, LLC. Please join the celebration party on March 12 from 6pm – 8pm. There will be live music, appetizers, and raffles!

NATIONAL SLAM THE SCAM DAY - MARCH 5TH

On March 5, 2026, during National Consumer Protection Week, the Social Security Administration (SSA) and its Office of the Inspector General (OIG) will lead National Slam the Scam Day.

Take part by using tools from SSA and the Federal Trade Commission (FTC) to recognize imposters — including Social Security-related scams — and stop scammers from stealing your money and personal information.

Help Us Slam the Scam!

1. Learn about common tactics and how to recognize the signs. For example:
 - An unexpected problem or offer of a prize or government benefit increase.
 - Pressure to act immediately.
 - Request for unusual payments like cryptocurrency, gift cards, gold bars, cash, or wire transfers, even with the promise of keeping your money safe.
2. Spread the word. Visit ssa.gov/scam for more information that could help you and others stay safe.
3. Report suspicious activity. Report Social Security-related issues to SSA OIG (oig.ssa.gov/report) and other concerns to the FTC (reportfraud.ftc.gov).

ELECTRIC RATE RENEWAL – MARCH 2026

The current electric rate offered through the association's broker / supplier (AUS/MC2) expires in March 2026. The current rate is 6.95 cents per kWh and the **renewal is a fixed rate of 8.75 cents per kWh for 12 months.** While this is an increase of almost 2 cents, it is 9% less than the current ComEd rate of 9.66 per kWh. If you are currently on this plan, you will receive a notice advising you of the new rate. You do not need to do anything to stay with this rate. If you would like to opt out, instructions will be on the notice on how to do so.

Did you know?

The Illinois Commerce Commission regulates utilities for the state of IL? Before switching electric suppliers, do your homework as many may entice you with low rates which are variable and will rise. Visit [Plugin Illinois](#) for more information on suppliers, their rates, and performance ratings.

WHAT NOT TO PUT DOWN THE DRAIN OR TOILET

The association spends thousands of dollars each year on correcting preventable sewer backups. These are backups caused by products that end up in our sewer system which should not be there. The sanitary system is designed to dispose of water, human waste and toilet paper... nothing else.

Please do not place items down your drains & toilets including but not limited to:

Cat Litter (even the "flushable" type)	Coffee Grinds	Corrosive Substances that are either acidic or caustic
Cleaning Wipes (even the "flushable" type)	Hand Towels / Paper Towels / Tissue	Dental Floss
Fats, Oils, or Grease (Butter or Margarine, Cooking Oil, Shortening, Lard)	Diapers (infant or adult)	Motor Oil, Transmission Fluids, Anti- Freeze or Other Toxic Chemicals
Prescription and Over-the-Counter Medications	Produce Stickers	Solvents, Paints, Turpentine, Nail Polish, Polish Remover
Flammable or Explosive Substances	Feminine Hygiene Products	Food

Yo Mama!

This space is devoted to tips and info to help Mother Earth, desperately in need of our TLC.

Spring forward with spring cleaning!

The most any of us really needs for everyday cleaning are items commonly found in the home: vinegar, baking soda and lemon. There is no need to buy toxic, expensive cleaners that that are not good to breath or wash down the drain.

Try these:

All purpose cleaner: One part white vinegar with 4 parts water. Add a little lemon juice for a refreshing smell. I just used this mixture to clean my refrigerator shelves and insides.

Scrubbing paste: Combine baking soda with a little dish soap and water to make a thick paste. Great to clean tubs, sinks and pots.

Glass cleaner: Mix a TBLS of vinegar into a quart of water.

Disinfectant: Mix 50/50 mix of vinegar and water.

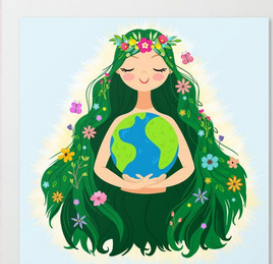
Oven cleaner: Use a thick paste of baking soda and water, apply to tough spots and let set for awhile before using a scrubber to remove.

Avoid paper towels by using old newspaper to wipe your glass surfaces. Old towels, sheets etc. can be washed and reused again and again. Microfiber cloths are long lasting and when used with just water alone are effective for cleaning.

Lastly, while we are on the subject of cleaning why not look to see what you did not wear this winter and perhaps not last winter. Get rid of the clutter. Donate gently used and still wearable items to nearby Goodwill stores or other.

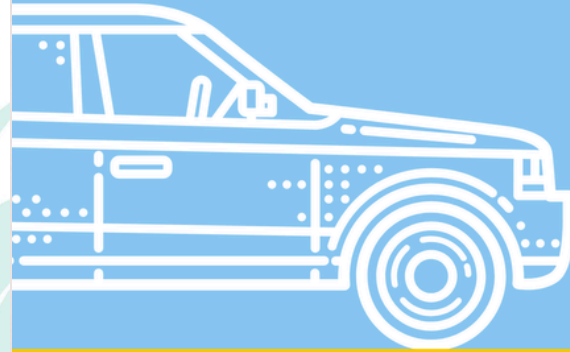

Bird & Butterfly Club



As spring approaches and we begin to think of warm weather, flowers and **BEAUTIFUL BUTTERFLIES** here's some important information to keep in mind when we plan our summer gardens, whether in the ground or in pots! Both insecticides and herbicides can be harmful to monarchs and other pollinators. Systemic insecticides (those we put in the ground) play a role in pollinator declines worldwide. Plants absorb systemic insecticides and as plants grow the toxins are distributed throughout the plant tissue including the leaves and nectar. Monarch caterpillars that feed on the leaves of treated plants are poisoned.



Before purchasing plants from nurseries and garden centers be sure to ask whether they have been treated with systemic insecticides, especially neonicotinoids which are toxic to pollinators. To read more visit xerces.org/pesticides.

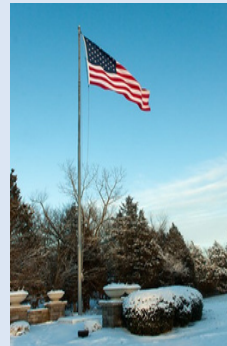

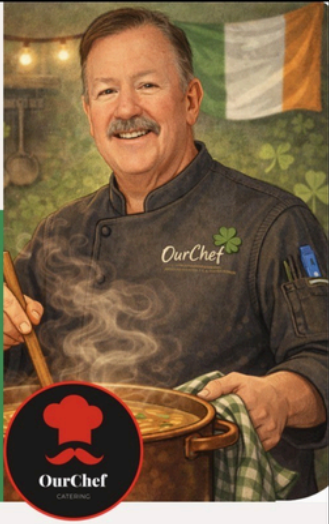
