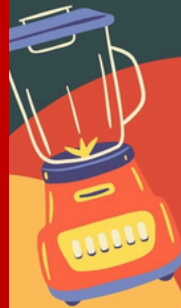

# Butterfly Garden Corner

This is an exciting update for the Lake BarringtonShores (LBS) community! The butterfly garden transformation is officially moving forward with a clear three-phase plan.

## *Phase 1 & 2: Preparation and Hardscape*

The first two phases have been awarded to Clarence Davids and Company, a contractor with a long history of landscaping work in Lake Barrington Shores. Both phases are scheduled for completion this Spring.

### Phase 1: Bed Preparation

Elimination of existing vegetation.

Reshaping the garden bed for a more aesthetic look.

Adding organic soil amendments and tilling.

Finishing with triple ground mulch.

### Phase 2: Hardscape

Installation of two stone paths.

Incorporation of existing stepping stones with new materials.

Cost Coverage: The Landscape department will cover the costs for phase 2.



## *Phase 3: Planting and Art*

This final stage is the "signature" part of the garden, though its timeline depends on fundraising. The goal is to install this in Fall 2026.

Key Features: Purchasing and installing garden plants and the butterfly sculpture.

Certification: Once complete, the garden will apply for certification by the North American Butterfly Association as a butterfly-friendly habitat.

Funding Status: This contract cannot be awarded until total funds are raised.

## *Fundraising & Community Support*

The project has already seen generous support from the community and the Birds and Butterfly Club and the Village of Lake Barrington.

- Current Progress: The GoFundMe campaign has raised nearly \$700 in a short period.

## LBCHA (MASTER) BOARD MEETING HIGHLIGHTS – APRIL 2026

Highlights from the April 2026 Master Board meeting are summarized below. These highlights do not include all actions taken. For full meeting details, please refer to the official meeting minutes.\*

**Saturday Work Session**– The Board held its preparation work session on Saturday, April 4 reviewing business for the upcoming meeting. At this meeting, due to low inventory, the Board of Directors approved the purchase of a new motor for the pontoon boat. The board also voted on the outcome of several violation hearings.

### **Marina Tables & Accessories**

The Board of Directors approved the purchase of new picnic tables for the marina.

### **Charter Clubs**

The Board of Directors approved the renewal of 49 Charter Clubs. The renewal is through the end of 2027. The board also approved new charter clubs: In Good Company, Current Events, and Ping Pong Drop In. Please watch Shores Weekly for upcoming club events.

### **Lake & Ponds**

The Board of Directors approved additional testing for the lake as recommended by the Lake and Ponds Commission. The purpose of this testing is to benchmark data for future planning.

## SPRING TURF TREATMENT

Beary Landscape will be applying granular turf fertilizer and pre-emergent property wide on April 22 and 23rd. The purpose of the pre-emergent is to create a protective barrier in the soil that kills germinating weed seeds. Beary will be mindful of skipping bare areas and areas that are being seeded due to plow damage.

You will see small white flags placed in the lawn area after the applicator has been through. Please use caution and stay off the grass as much as possible for 24 hrs after application.



## GARBAGE BIN STORAGE REMINDER

Garbage and recycle containers must be stored indoors at all times. Most, though not all, Associations within LBS allow the containers to be placed outside either after 6:00 PM or after dusk the night before the scheduled pick-up day. The containers must then be placed back inside your garage on the same day as pick-up. Some Associations do not allow containers to be moved outside the evening before pick-up and you must wait to put them outside until the morning of the scheduled pick-up day. Please review your rule book or contact the management office if you are unsure of your individual Association's rules.

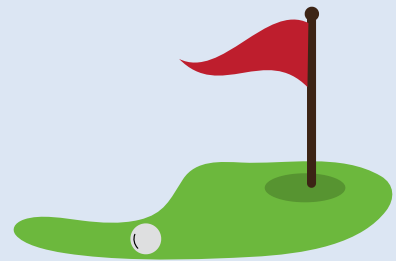

Along with the usual cardinals, robins, juncos and chickadees, these birds can be seen foraging on the tender young buds of our abundant trees or picking in the branches and ground for insects and worms. In addition, this week we have seen an **American white pelican**.

*Common flicker*

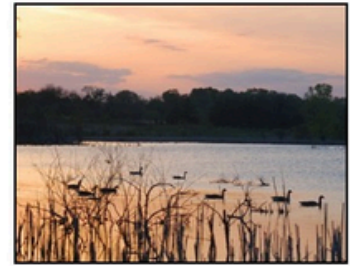
These giant birds are 4 feet tall with a 9 foot wingspan! They migrate through Illinois looking for fish in freshwater lakes, ponds, and rivers. Pelicans have a particular feeding style - they don't dive, rather, they dip their large throat pouches into the lake, collecting up to three gallons of water along with schools of fish.
