LANDSCAPING LOOK AHEAD - APRIL 2026

The 2026 landscaping season has begun with spring clean-up activities underway. If Beary Landscaping hasn't made it to your condo association yet, they will shortly! Also please note that weekly pickup of compostable yard waste on Mondays has resumed. (Important! Non-compostable yard waste and yard waste left in plastic trash bags will NOT be picked up.)

Landscaping activities planned for April are listed below. Please note that we will be issuing a first-ever "special edition" of Shores, which is scheduled to be sent out via email the week of April 6th.

As previously announced, Mary Albanese, the LBS Landscape Manager the past three years, has retired. The search for Mary's replacement is underway. As Mary's email is no longer active, please direct landscape emails meant for First Service to landscape@LBS-hoa.org. For most other landscaping issues, you may contact your condo association's Landscape Representative.

As always, our goal is to provide useful, timely information about the activities and services that support and maintain one of our community's greatest assets – our beautiful landscape.

Monthly "Look-Ahead": Planned Landscaping Activities for April 2026:

- Spring Clean-up – Underway*
- "Shores" Special Landscaping Issue – Week of April 6
- Weekly Mowing Begins – Mid-April*
- Pre-emergent Turf Treatment – 1st half of April*
- Mulch Application for C1-4 & C6-9 – April/May (following spring clean-up)*
- Walk-throughs for 2026 Building Enhancements – April-May (letters to affected homeowners will be distributed 2 weeks prior to scheduled walk-through)*

SNOW PLOW DAMAGE

Spring is just around the corner, and with any luck, our days of surprise snowfalls are behind us. As many of you know, winter plowing can cause occasional disruption to

turf and landscaping throughout the community. Our maintenance crews have already begun addressing these areas by resetting boulders, removing debris, and resetting existing sod.

Please keep in mind that the **Public Works Department is responsible for all snow-related damage repairs**, as outlined in the snowplow contracts.

All repairs must be completed **no later than April 30th.**

We have already catalogued the areas needing attention; however, if you notice additional damage, you may submit a work order at www.lakebarringtonshores.org.

As temperatures rise and new seed is installed near your home, **a little watering will go a long way** in helping the turf establish and regrow successfully.

Community Corner

AC CHECK



What you can do yourself Before you call a technician to service your system, cross these tasks off your maintenance to-do list.

Clean what you can

Clean or replace any filters inside your system's indoor unit. Also, clear away any dirt, leaves, and debris from your system's outdoor unit. Pro tip: Keep plants, weeds, shrubs, and other vegetation at least 18 inches away from your outdoor unit to avoid debris buildup.

Watch out for leaks

Check for leaks or holes in your system's ductwork, evaporator coil, or cabinet (the outside "shell" of your unit that holds all the parts inside together).

Keep your ears open

Listen closely for any strange noises when your system starts. If you hear any, call a technician to inspect the problem more closely.

Perform a smell test

Take note of any suspicious or unusual odors when your system starts. If you smell anything strange, call a technician to identify the issue.

Keep your vents clear

Make sure you move any furniture, drapes, rugs, etc. that could be blocking your supply and return vents.

When to call a technician

There are some situations only a professional should handle. Here's when you need to call in an expert.

Your energy bills keep rising

If your utility bills increase but your overall usage remains the same, one or more components of your system may not be working as they should.

Your comfort isn't consistent

If your air conditioner, furnace or other HVAC system can't maintain consistent temperatures, a technician is the best person to investigate the issue.

Your unit's fins are damaged

Bent or damaged fins on your air conditioner or heat pump's outdoor unit can trap heat inside your unit, causing performance and temperature issues.

Your unit takes on a lot of water

Excessive water, such as from a flood, can seriously damage your unit's electrical systems. If you suspect that your unit's mechanical equipment might have water damage, do not attempt to resolve the issue yourself. Call a technician. Electrical problems are potentially life-threatening and should only be handled by a professional.

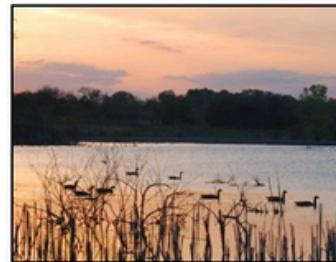
These giant birds are 4 feet tall with a 9 foot wingspan! They migrate through Illinois looking for fish in freshwater lakes, ponds, and rivers. Pelicans have a particular feeding style - they don't dive, rather, they dip their large throat pouches into the lake, collecting up to three gallons of water along with schools of fish.

They raise their bills to drain the water, then swallow their prize! And here's an adorable little American tree sparrow spotted here at LBS (courtesy Sue Beyer)

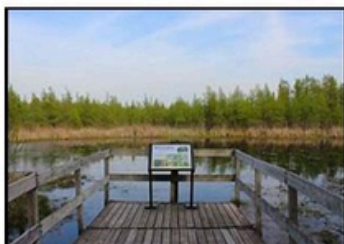

Butterfly Garden Corner

This is an exciting update for the Lake Barrington Shores (LBS) community! The butterfly garden transformation is officially moving forward with a clear three-phase plan.

Phase 1 & 2: Preparation and Hardscape

The first two phases have been awarded to Clarence Davids and Company, a contractor with a long history of landscaping work in Lake Barrington Shores. Both phases are scheduled for completion this Spring.

Phase 1: Bed Preparation

Elimination of existing vegetation.
Reshaping the garden bed for a more aesthetic look.
Adding organic soil amendments and tilling.
Finishing with triple ground mulch.

Phase 2: Hardscape

Installation of two stone paths.
Incorporation of existing stepping stones with new materials.

Cost Coverage: The Landscape department will cover the costs for phase 2.



Phase 3: Planting and Art

This final stage is the "signature" part of the garden, though its timeline depends on fundraising. The goal is to install this in Fall 2026.

Key Features: Purchasing and installing garden plants and the butterfly sculpture.

Certification: Once complete, the garden will apply for certification by the North American Butterfly Association as a butterfly-friendly habitat.

Funding Status: This contract cannot be awarded until total funds are raised.

Fundraising & Community Support

The project has already seen generous support from the community and the Birds and Butterfly Club and the Village of Lake Barrington.

- Current Progress: The GoFundMe campaign has raised nearly \$700 in a short period.
- How to Help: Residents can contribute directly via the Project GoFundMe Link.
