OUTDOOR POOL

The Outdoor Pool is open daily from 4:30am - 9:00pm.

- You **are required** to show a valid LBS ID card to access the outdoor pool. **Those without a LBS ID card will be turned away.**
- Guests **are required** be accompanied by LBS residents. **Guests may not use a resident's ID card, they will be turned away.**
- Children under age 16 **are required** to have an adult with them for the entire duration of their time at the pool.
- No food or drinks (other than water) are allowed on the pool deck. You may utilize the patio adjacent to the pool for eating and drinking.
- Guests are permitted to bring 4 guests each time they visit the pool. In addition to the 4 guests you are allocated 10 additional guest passes to be used throughout the year. These can be accessed when you check in with the pool attendant.
- Floats are not permitted at the pool, with the exception of personal floatation devices and "noodle" type floating devices.
- For a complete list of pool rules please see pages 33 - 36 in the rule book.

The Outdoor Pool is NOT guarded by lifeguards and is SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK.

MARINA AND BEACH

The Marina is staffed Monday - Friday from 12:00pm - 8:00pm and

Saturdays / Sundays / Holidays from 10:00am - 8:00pm

Marina: 224-545-7462 (during open hours)

- You may check out a row boat or kayak at the Main Gate between sunrise - 12:00pm (weekdays) and sunrise - 10:00am (weekends and holidays). You will need your LBS ID card.
- Free Rides are offered on the Pontoon Boat Monday - Friday at 1:00pm and 2:00pm and on weekends / holidays at 11:00am, 12:00pm, 1:00pm, and 2:00pm. This schedule may be adjusted on Sundays when a Sailing Race is scheduled. All Sailing Races will be listed on the monthly calendar included in "The Shores Weekly".
- All swimmers must swim in the designated swim area.
- Fishing should only be done from the pier side and is not permitted from the beach side
- No Dogs Allowed at the Beach

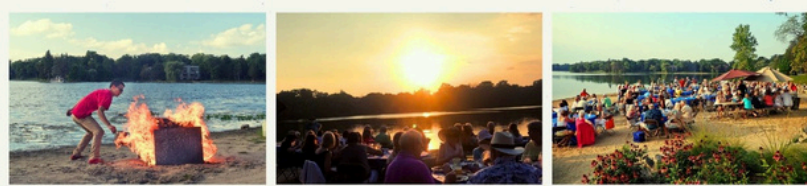

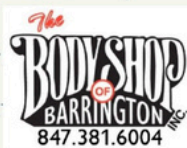

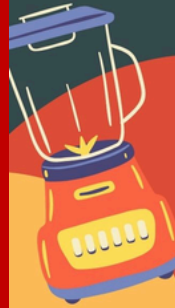

Community Corner

LBCHA (MASTER) BOARD MEETING HIGHLIGHTS – MAY 2026

Highlights from the May 2026 Master Board meeting are summarized below. These highlights do not include all actions taken. For full meeting details, please refer to the official meeting minutes.*

Saturday Work Session – The Board held its preparation work session on Saturday, May 9 reviewing business for the upcoming meeting. The board also voted on the outcome of several violation hearings.

Marina Chairs

The Board of Directors approved the purchase of new chairs for the marina.

Public Works

The Board of Directors approved seven (7) motions addressing infrastructure needs identified by the Public Works Commission. These motions include:

- Repair of the perimeter fence along North Bay
- Replacement of a failing storm sewer
- Extensive piping repairs to two (2) lift stations
- Purchase of a larger pump for the Hilltop lift station
- Replacement of aeration piping at the wastewater treatment plant
- Purchase of a dehumidifier for facility maintenance

Stormwater Management Plan

The Board contracted an engineering firm to develop a comprehensive stormwater management plan for the association. The final draft—designed to proactively improve stormwater infrastructure throughout the property—was reviewed and approved.

Public Safety Reminder: E-Bikes, Scooters, and Motorized Vehicles

Residents are reminded that e-bikes and scooters must follow the same traffic laws as automobiles when operated on roadways.

⚠ Safety Notice: Incidents have been reported involving e-bikes and scooters failing to stop at intersections. For everyone’s safety, please ride responsibly and obey all posted signage.

🚫 Restriction: E-bikes and motorized scooters are **not permitted** on Lake Path.

Community Corner

LBS GOLF CLUB, LLC – QUARTERLY FINANCIAL REPORT

Below is the quarterly Lake Barrington Shores Golf Club, LLC financials through March 31, 2026. March continues to reflect the Club's seasonal pre-opening period, with no golf activity and most of the revenue generated through Food & Beverage operations. While overall revenue slightly exceeded budget on a year-to-date basis, operating losses widened due to elevated course preparation expenses, higher Food & Beverage cost of sales, and increased administrative costs as the Club prepares for the upcoming golf season.

The budget for membership sales is 106.13% of the goal for a revenue total of \$546,840. You will note that membership revenue is not listed on the March financial. This revenue is deferred and will be shown on the financials from April – Oct.

These results remain consistent with the seasonal nature of golf operations, where the majority of revenue is generated between April and October. As seasonal revenue increases, the Club expects opportunities to recover early-season variances and improve overall financial performance in the coming months.

Your dishwasher is your friend!

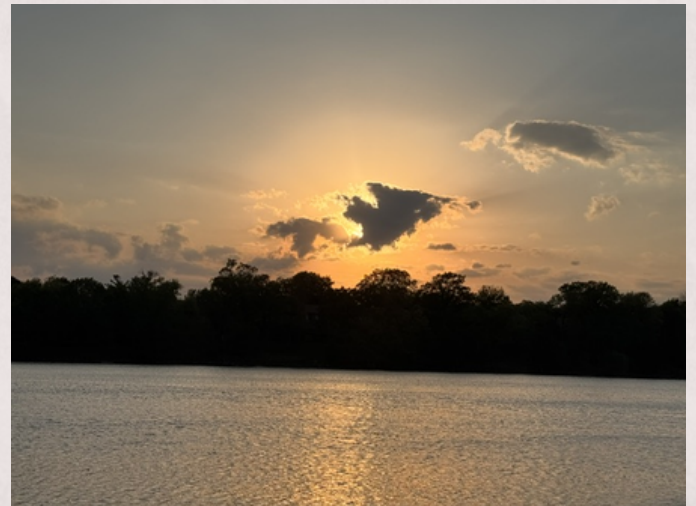
As mentioned before your dishwasher is a far more efficient and environmentally sound means of washing your dishes than by hand in the sink. Keep these things in mind to get the most out of your dishwasher.

1. Scrape food off of plates. Rinsing is unnecessary. That's the job of your dishwasher. No need to put nearly clean plates in the racks!
2. Do not overload. Overloading crowds the dishes and does not allow the water to get around everything. Some things may not get completely clean.
3. Do not under load. Why waste the energy? Place enough items inside to get the most out of your load.
4. Pots and pans are fine. Yes they take up a lot of space but think of how much water it takes to clean a pot or pan in the sink.
5. Try doing without the drying options. If you are doing a load later in the day or evening maybe you can let the dishes dry on their own overnight. A little hand drying might be necessary.
6. Finally, I have used both generic brand pods and more expensive name brands. I cannot tell the difference???

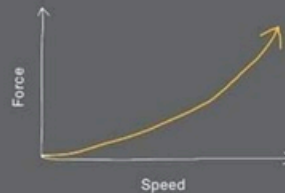

How Speed Kills

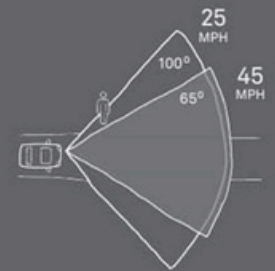

Crashes at higher speeds are more **forceful** and thus more likely to be fatal



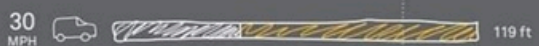

Forest Preserve Conservators

Plant of the Week – Garlic Mustard/Invasive

The Conservators remove more than invasive trees and shrubs, like buckthorn and honeysuckle. We also remove invasive plants, which do not support our pollinators, because they did not evolve to eat them. This time of year, we focus on the removal of invasive plants such as garlic mustard. We have focused on it for several years and have reduced it somewhat, but it is stubborn and has sprung up in areas we have cleared recently. The largest patch I have seen this year is just south of the marina.

Garlic mustard originated in Europe, Asia, and northwestern Africa. It spreads aggressively and, if allowed to go to seed, can produce up to 6,000 seeds, which can remain viable for years. It can form into dense colonies, which pushes out natives. It leafs out early, which helps it out compete natives. Like dandelions, it can be eaten in salads and used in soups. Garlic mustard is not a relative of garlic. It is a member of the mustard family.
