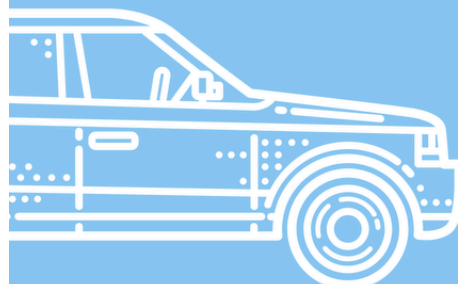

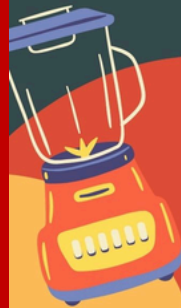

SUMMER GARDENING TIPS

If you're thinking about enhancing the common-area beds around your home for the summer, one of the easiest things you can do is add seasonal ("annual") plants to an existing bed. Keep in mind, however, that your plantings must not:

- Interfere with existing ground cover or other existing perennials and/or shrubs.
- Require any change to the size and/or shape of an existing common-area bed.
- Appear on the LBS Landscaping **Do Not Plant / Plant with Care** list.

Another easy way to add seasonal color to areas outside your home – and one favored by many homeowners – is to plant annuals in pots and planters on a deck or balcony, in a courtyard or near their front door.

With either approach, no Work Order Request or **Landscape Variance Application (LVA)** is required. Important: You will be responsible for maintaining any annuals you plant.

If you wish, you can make more substantive changes to the landscape around your – including replacing and/or adding perennials or shrubs – but only if you first submit an **LVA**, which will require review and approval by the LBS Landscape Manager and approval of your Condominium Board of Directors. (LVA approval ensures that inappropriate or "invasive" species aren't introduced to the property and that ongoing maintenance of any new plantings will be within the scope of the landscape maintenance contracts has with its landscaping vendors.

ANNUAL MEMBERSHIP MEETING & ELECTION QUESTIONS

As we enter the time of year when many LBS Associations have their Annual Meetings, now is a good opportunity to review questions we routinely receive on this topic. Every year, each condominium association and the master association is required to call an “Annual Meeting of the Membership”. This is the one meeting each year which is not a Board Meeting and is a meeting of the Members (homeowners) within the association. One of the primary purposes of the meeting is to elect open positions for the Board of Directors. Below are some Frequently Asked Questions:

What does my percentage of ownership have to do with the election process?

Your percentage of ownership is the percentage of what you own of the association. This percentage not only determines your assessment amount, but also the weight of your vote. According to the IL Condominium Property Act and each Condominium Association’s Declaration and By-laws, you must have a quorum (minimum) of 20% of the owners represented in person or by proxy. Quorum is calculated by adding the percentage of ownership of each owner present in person or by proxy.

My spouse and I both own our home. Can we both vote?

No, there is one vote per home regardless of the number of people that own that home.

What is cumulative voting?

In order for an association to use cumulative voting, it must be stated in the associations By-laws. Currently, all of the LBS Condominium Association’s except one allow for cumulative voting. This means when you cast your ballot, you may apply multiple votes to a candidate or candidates instead of applying one vote to each candidate.

What is the difference between a Proxy/Ballot and a Ballot?

The definition of Proxy is “the authority to represent someone else, especially in voting.” A Proxy/Ballot is a proxy in which you state your preference to your proxy (the person or entity) on how you want to vote. All proxies used at LBS are revocable proxies, meaning, you may revoke the proxy and replace it at any time before the election.

A ballot is different from a proxy in that a ballot can only be cast by a homeowner within the association. Ballots are issued the night of the meeting. Ballots can also be used in place of proxies, if the association adopts rules regarding this. Currently three (3) of the thirteen (13) condo associations use a mail in ballot process instead of proxies.

Why don’t we have term limits for board members?

In order for board members to have term limits, this would have to be defined in your association’s By-laws which it is not. Additionally, this is also not a requirement of the IL Condominium Property Act. Since being a board member is an unpaid, volunteer position, it can be challenging for associations to have homeowners who volunteer annually. It is thought by many that imposing term limits would create larger issues for associations and the inability of the board to continue. Instead, owners should exercise their right to vote and also consider volunteering as a board member.

Who elects the President, Vice President, and Treasurer?

After the homeowners of the association elect the members to the board, the members of the board determine who holds an officer position. The term of an officer is for one year, while a term of a board member is two years. Members can serve multiple terms as an officer if their board elects them to do so. The President of each condominium association has a seat on the Lake Barrington Community Homeowners Association (Master) Board.
