You already know walking is good for you. But did you know that people who walk with an animal are more likely to meet physical activity recommendations? LBS residents and their guests are encouraged to come walk (with or without your pet) and we'll be joined by our friends at Soul Harbor Ranch and their mini therapy horses and therapy dogs. The little guys will accompany us on our walk to get their daily exercise!

Meet at Marina Rooftop. 30 minute walk followed by 30 minute social. Weather Permitting. No sign-up required.

**The SOUL Harbour Ranch Animal Therapy Program (501(c)3) offers Animal-Assisted Interventions (fun activity, therapy and educational visits and programs) within the Barrington and surrounding communities with their registered mini therapy horses, mini therapy donkeys and therapy dogs. They visit nursing homes, homes for the disabled, community outings and even hospitals!

OUTDOOR POOL

The Outdoor Pool is open daily from 4:30am - 9:00pm.

The Outdoor Pool is NOT guarded by lifeguards and is SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK.

- You **are required** to show a valid LBS ID card to access the outdoor pool. **Those without a LBS ID card will be turned away.**
- Guests **are required** be accompanied by LBS residents. **Guests may not use a resident's ID card, they will be turned away.**
- Children under age 16 **are required** to have an adult with them for the entire duration of their time at the pool.
- No food or drinks (other than water) are allowed on the pool deck. You may utilize the patio adjacent to the pool for eating and drinking.
- Guests are permitted to bring 4 guests each time they visit the pool. In addition to the 4 guests you are allocated 10 additional guest passes to be used throughout the year. These can be accessed when you check in with the pool attendant.
- Floats are not permitted at the pool, with the exception of personal floatation devices and "noodle" type floating devices.
- For a complete list of pool rules please see pages 33 - 36 in the rule book.

MARINA AND BEACH

The Marina is staffed Monday - Friday from 12:00pm - 8:00pm and

Saturdays / Sundays / Holidays from 10:00am - 8:00pm

Marina: 224-545-7462 (during open hours)

The Lake is NOT guarded by lifeguards and is SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK

- You may check out a row boat or kayak at the Main Gate between sunrise - 12:00pm (weekdays) and sunrise - 10:00am (weekends and holidays). You will need your LBS ID card.
- Free Rides are offered on the Pontoon Boat Monday - Friday at 1:00pm and 2:00pm and on weekends / holidays at 11:00am, 12:00pm, 1:00pm, and 2:00pm. This schedule may be adjusted on Sundays when a Sailing Race is scheduled. All Sailing Races will be listed on the monthly calendar included in "The Shores Weekly".
- All swimmers must swim in the designated swim area.
- Fishing should only be done from the pier side and is not permitted from the beach side
- No Dogs Allowed at the Beach
- For a complete list of marina / beach rules please see pages 38-43 in the rule book.

Beach Party Guidelines

- Only one beach party can be booked per day. Parties can never take over the entire beach. There will be a maximum of 35 people per party.
- Three picnic tables and one of the grills are included with your beach rental.
- The Beach must be kept clean. Final cleanup must have all waste contained in plastic bags and deposited in the proper receptacle provided.
- A refundable deposit of \$100 is required at time of sign-up. Should additional cleanup be required, those costs will be taken from that deposit. Any unused remaining balance will be refunded, and any costs above \$100 will be assessed to the unit owner's account.

Community Corner

REMINDER TO RESIDENTS - OF CURRENT ILLINOIS STATE & LBS E-BIKES AND SCOOTERS RULES & REGULATIONS

At the June meeting of the Master Board, a motion was approved directing the Rules & Regulations Commission to review the current rules and enforcement policies regarding e-bikes and scooters, and to recommend additional measures to help improve safety within the community.

In the meantime, we would like to remind all residents that the following rules are currently in effect in LBS:

- Motorized bikes and scooters are not permitted on the lake path at any time, regardless of whether they are being pedaled or operated by motor power.
- Bikes and scooters must follow the same traffic laws as automobiles, including:
 - Coming to a complete stop at stop signs
 - Obeying posted speed limits
 - Yielding appropriately to pedestrians and vehicles

In addition, Illinois currently classifies e-bikes as bicycles if they are equipped with pedals and a motor under 750 watts:

- Class 1: Pedal-assist only, maximum speed of 20 mph
- Class 2: Throttle-assist, maximum speed of 20 mph
- Class 3: Pedal-assist only, maximum speed of 28 mph; operators must be at least 16 years old

Illinois law also requires appropriate lighting and reflectors for night riding.

Current Illinois regulations for e-scooters include:

- Riders must be at least 18 years old
- Scooters are generally permitted only on streets with speed limits of 35 mph or lower
- Maximum operating speeds are typically limited to 10-15 mph, depending on local jurisdiction

The State of Illinois is expected to implement additional laws and regulations regarding these vehicles beginning in 2027.

Unfortunately, there have been numerous instances where both LBS rules and Illinois traffic laws have not been followed. Reports have included bikes and scooters failing to stop at stop signs, riding on the lake path, and operating recklessly on community streets, including passing moving vehicles.

For the safety of all residents, pedestrians, drivers, and riders, please ensure that all bikes and scooters are operated responsibly and in compliance with both community rules and Illinois law.

Thank you for your cooperation in helping keep LBS safe for everyone.

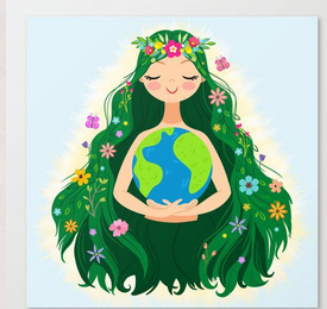

Clean or replace any filters inside your system's indoor unit. Also, clear away any dirt, leaves, and debris from your system's outdoor unit. Pro tip: Keep plants, weeds, shrubs, and other vegetation at least 18 inches away from your outdoor unit to avoid debris buildup.

Watch out for leaks

Check for leaks or holes in your system's ductwork, evaporator coil, or cabinet (the outside "shell" of your unit that holds all the parts inside together).

Keep your ears open

Listen closely for any strange noises when your system starts. If you hear any, call a technician to inspect the problem more closely.

Perform a smell test

Take note of any suspicious or unusual odors when your system starts. If you smell anything strange, call a technician to identify the issue.

Keep your vents clear

Make sure you move any furniture, drapes, rugs, etc. that could be blocking your supply and return vents.

When to call a technician

There are some situations only a professional should handle. Here's when you need to call in an expert.

Your energy bills keep rising

If your utility bills increase but your overall usage remains the same, one or more components of your system may not be working as they should.

Your comfort isn't consistent

If your air conditioner, furnace or other HVAC system can't maintain consistent temperatures, a technician is the best person to investigate the issue.

Your unit's fins are damaged

Bent or damaged fins on your air conditioner or heat pump's outdoor unit can trap heat inside your unit, causing performance and temperature issues.

Your unit takes on a lot of water

Excessive water, such as from a flood, can seriously damage your unit's electrical systems. If you suspect that your unit's mechanical equipment might have water damage, do not attempt to resolve the issue yourself. Call a technician. Electrical problems are potentially life-threatening and should only be handled by a professional.

Now that the golf course is officially open for the season, we would like to remind all residents of an important safety policy regarding course access.

During golf season, the golf course is closed to all non-golfers, including walkers, children, and pets. Over the past several days, golfers have encountered multiple instances of individuals walking on the course while play was underway. While everyone enjoys our beautiful grounds, the presence of non-golfers on an active course creates a serious safety risk.

Golf balls can travel at very high speeds and often without warning. Even the most cautious golfer cannot always prevent an errant shot, and the risk of injury—particularly to young children—is significant. In addition to personal safety concerns, unauthorized access also raises potential liability and insurance issues for our community.

During the Golf Season, We kindly ask all residents to help us keep everyone safe by:

- **If you are not golfing, Avoiding the golf course entirely during the golf season, and**
- **Respecting posted signage and staff instructions**

These measures are not meant to limit enjoyment of the community, but rather to ensure that golfers and non-golfers alike can coexist safely.

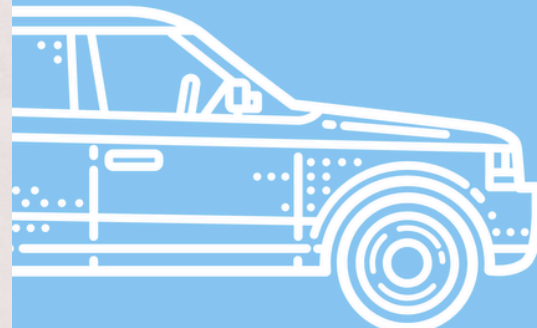

WEEDS, WEEDS GO AWAY

Whether you actively garden or not, weeds are something about which we all agree: There are too many (and they seem to be everywhere), they are hard to prevent, and they can be hard to eliminate.

Weeding is provided as part of our landscaping maintenance services – our contract with Beary Landscaping provides for weeding in garden beds four (4) times a year, and application of weed-controlling herbicides to our lawns three (3) times a year – but weeds grow fast and can often return before the next scheduled weeding or herbicide treatment. While LBS homeowners aren't expected to weed, some enjoy working in the garden beds around their home; if you're among them, your efforts to help “weed” are greatly appreciated!

For those willing and able, there are several ways you can help to control weeds naturally:

- Hand-pull weeds, ensuring to remove the roots to prevent regrowth.
- Boil water and pour it directly onto the weeds to scald them.
- Spray weeds with vinegar (acetic acid – a natural herbicide).
- Apply salt to the base of the weeds (but be cautious as it can affect surrounding plants).
- Mulch around plants to block sunlight and prevent weed growth.
- Use corn gluten meal as a pre-emergent herbicide to inhibit seed germination.

Borax is also an effective weed killer. You'll find it alongside cleaning products in the supermarket. It is extremely alkaline with a pH of about 9.5. Simply dissolve 1/2 cup of borax in 1 gallon of water and spray directly on the leaves of unwanted plants. Reminder: Borax is toxic if ingested, so keep it away from kids and pets.

While your local nursery or hardware store may sell a variety of weed control products, many (e.g., Round Up) are highly toxic and should be avoided. What's more, LBS does not permit individual application of herbicides; application of this type of product is allowed within LBS only by our landscape maintenance contractors, who are certified to use these products safely.

Important! Under our landscape maintenance contracts, weeding is not an “on-demand” service provided at homeowner request, so please don't submit a Work Order for weeding or request weeding when a landscaping team is on your property.

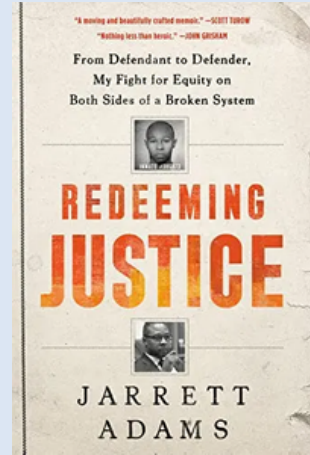
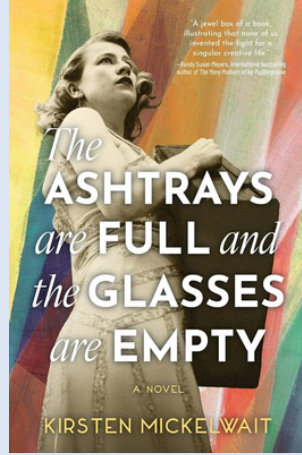

Forest Preserve Conservators

Plant of the Week – Golden Alexander/Native

One of the wonderful things about native areas is that the plants and trees you see will be different every time you walk by. Each plant blooms, puts out seeds, and changes color at its own pace. The availability of an ever-changing array of pollens is critical to pollinators. The same is true for birds and other animals that depend on berries or seeds. However, when you are highlighting a different plant each week, you may get a picture one week but its bloom may be gone by the time the article is published.

Golden Alexander is an example of this. If you went around the lake two weeks ago, you would have seen large clusters of small, bright yellow Golden Alexander flowers. But now, while the plants are still there, the flowers are gone. Golden Alexander grows to a height of 8-24" and produce leaves 1-4" long.

Golden Alexander is an example of a plant with a symbiotic relationship with a pollinator.

What Milkweed is to Monarchs, Golden Alexander is to Black Swallowtails. It is one of the primary food sources for larvae, and the plant is dependent on the adult butterflies' flit from flower to flower facilitating pollination.

Golden Alexander also is an example of a plant that has evolved to grow in a wide range of places, from meadows, shorelines, and moist woodlands, like our forest preserve.

checking feeders. It is said that every 9 cubic feet of space in the U.S. has been investigated by a hummingbird, so if you haven't seen one yet don't give up! Get yourself an inexpensive feeder - the one pictured is the best and easiest to keep clean. They are about \$12 or so at Ace Hardware and Home Depot. There are many beautiful feeders for sale but make sure it is one you can easily and thoroughly clean because that's important as bacteria and mold can build up and kill hummers. Here is a chart of how frequently your feeder should be cleaned and refilled (from Citizens for Conservation). And don't pay for premixed or red food mix. The best is to make it fresh with 8 oz boiling water, mix in 1/4 c granulated WHITE sugar (no brown, powdered or raw sugar as these be deadly) until it's fully dissolved, let it cool and pour it into your feeder. They often come around in the evening so relax and watch!

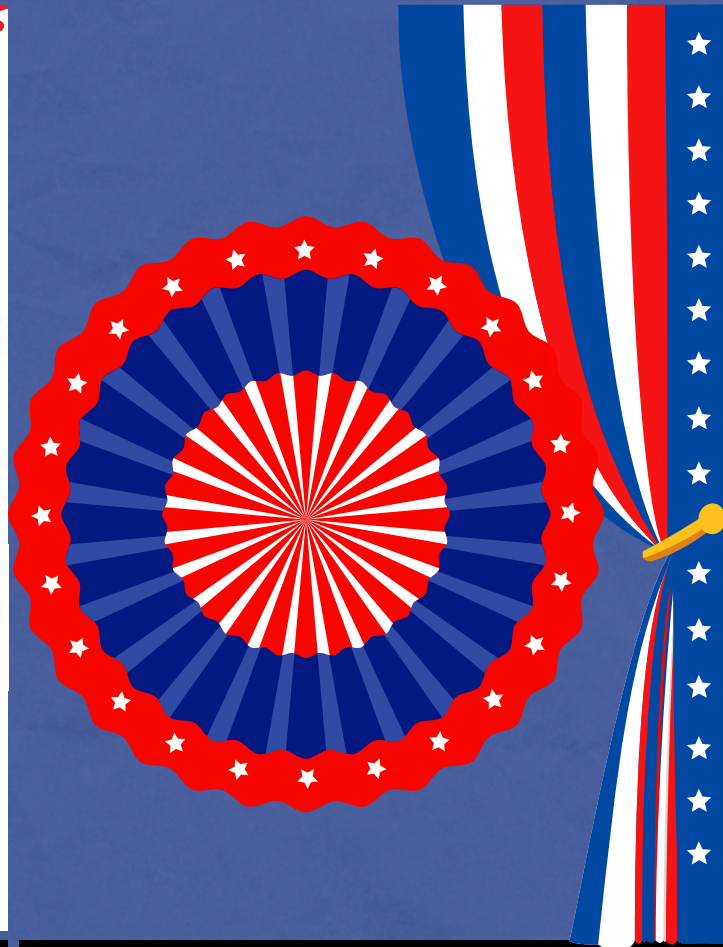

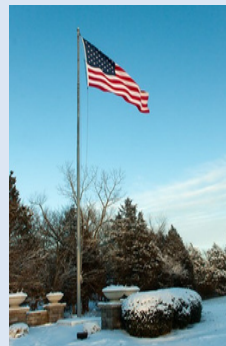
