OUTDOOR POOL

The Outdoor Pool is open daily from 4:30am - 9:00pm.

The Outdoor Pool is NOT guarded by lifeguards and is SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK.

- You **are required** to show a valid LBS ID card to access the outdoor pool. **Those without a LBS ID card will be turned away.**
- Guests **are required** be accompanied by LBS residents. **Guests may not use a resident's ID card, they will be turned away.**
- Children under age 16 **are required** to have an adult with them for the entire duration of their time at the pool.
- No food or drinks (other than water) are allowed on the pool deck. You may utilize the patio adjacent to the pool for eating and drinking.
- Guests are permitted to bring 4 guests each time they visit the pool. In addition to the 4 guests you are allocated 10 additional guest passes to be used throughout the year. These can be accessed when you check in with the pool attendant.
- Floats are not permitted at the pool, with the exception of personal floatation devices and "noodle" type floating devices.
- For a complete list of pool rules please see pages 33 - 36 in the rule book.

MARINA AND BEACH

The Marina is staffed Monday - Friday from 12:00pm - 8:00pm and

Saturdays / Sundays / Holidays from 10:00am - 8:00pm

The Lake is NOT guarded by lifeguards and is SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK

- You may check out a row boat or kayak at the Main Gate between sunrise - 12:00pm (weekdays) and sunrise - 10:00am (weekends and holidays). You will need your LBS ID card.
- **Free Rides** are offered on the Pontoon Boat Monday - Friday at 1:00pm and 2:00pm and on weekends / holidays at 11:00am, 12:00pm, 1:00pm, and 2:00pm. This schedule may be adjusted on Sundays when a Sailing Race is scheduled. All Sailing Races will be listed on the monthly calendar included in "The Shores Weekly".
- All swimmers must swim in the designated swim area.
- Fishing should only be done from the pier side and is not permitted from the beach side
- No Dogs Allowed at the Beach
- For a complete list of marina / beach rules please see pages 38-43 in the rule book.

Beach Party Guidelines

- Only one beach party can be booked per day. Parties can never take over the entire beach. There will be a maximum of 35 people per party.
- Three picnic tables and one of the grills are included with your beach rental.
- The Beach must be kept clean. Final cleanup must have all waste contained in plastic bags and deposited in the proper receptacle provided.
- A refundable deposit of \$100 is required at time of sign-up. Should additional cleanup be required, those costs will be taken from that deposit. Any unused remaining balance will be refunded, and any costs above \$100 will be assessed to the unit owner's account.

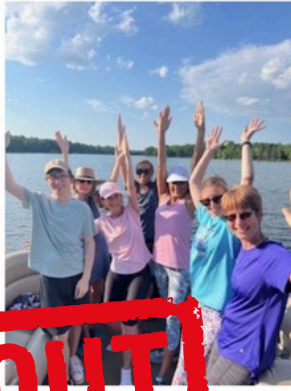

TURF TREATMENT NOTICE – JUNE 18–19

Please be advised that beginning Thursday, June 18, and continuing through Friday, June 19, Beary Landscaping will be onsite applying granular fertilizer and a liquid broadleaf weed control treatment to turf areas throughout the community. This work is expected to take approximately two days to complete and is weather-dependent.

We recommend that residents and pets remain off treated grass areas until the application has fully dried, which typically takes between 2–4 hours. You may notice small white flags placed in lawn areas following treatment. These flags indicate that the application has been completed in that specific area. 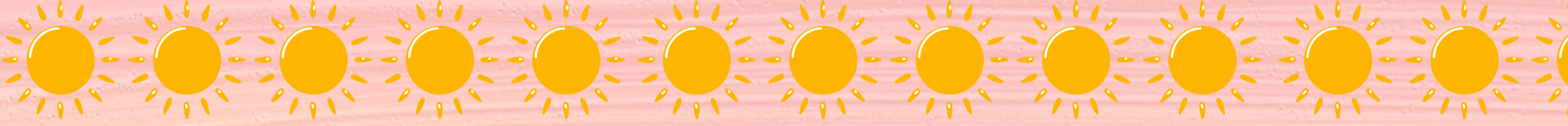

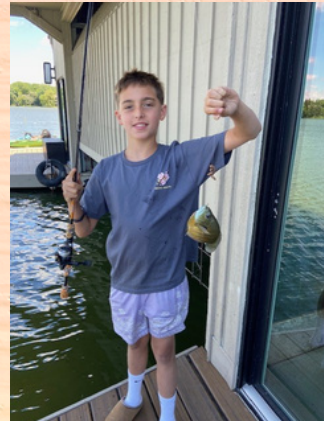

MANAGING OUR LANDSCAPING COSTS: WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

Landscaping maintenance services within Lake Barrington Shores are defined and managed under the commercial contracts we maintain with our landscaping vendors — Beary Landscaping, Bluestem Ecological Services, and Davey Tree.

Our annual landscaping budget is built around these contracts, which specify both the services each vendor will provide and the frequency with which those services will be performed.

The cost of most landscaping services throughout LBS is covered by a portion of the monthly assessments paid by homeowners. Of the average monthly HOA assessment, approximately 12% is allocated to landscape maintenance, including:

- Spring and fall clean-up
- Periodic turf mowing
- Weeding
- Herbicide and fertilizer applications
- Maintenance of shrubs and other perennials
- Care and maintenance of our natural areas
- Tree care and maintenance, including dormant pruning

When compared with the cost of maintaining the landscape of a private residence in the Barrington area, the cost to LBS homeowners is notably economical. Managing a community of our size within that budget is possible because these services are provided under commercial contracts that define the scope of work and service schedules.

At the same time, this approach means we are generally unable to provide customized, on-demand landscaping services for individual homeowners.

From time to time, however, landscaping needs arise that fall outside the scope of our maintenance contracts. Examples include replacing aging or declining perennials, reconfiguring or replanting garden beds, or reseeding damaged turf areas. These special projects require additional funding through the association which is limited and prioritized by need. However, owners have the option of escalating the timing of this work by utilizing the landscape variance process and self-funding.

Understanding the distinction between contracted maintenance services and on-demand services helps ensure that landscaping resources are used fairly and consistently throughout LBS.

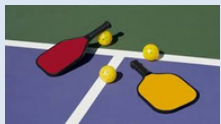

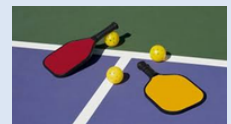


Here is a spiderwort plant with blooms and also a cluster of buds waiting to open.

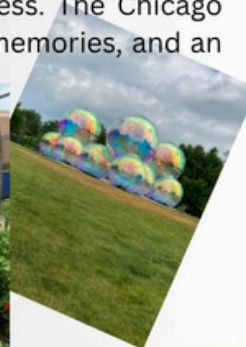
A Wonderful Day at Chicago Botanic Garden

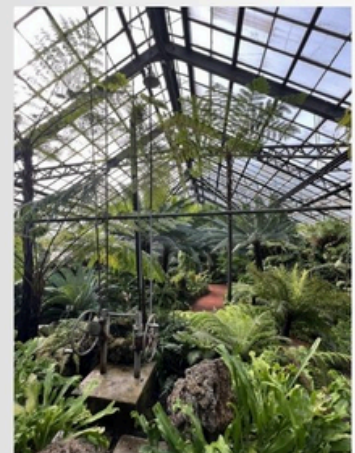

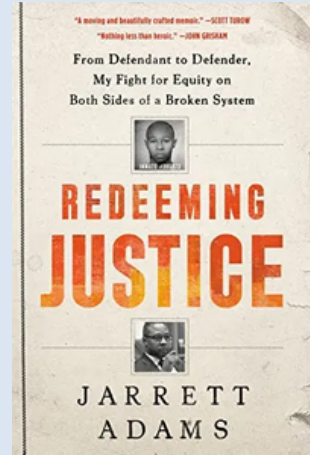
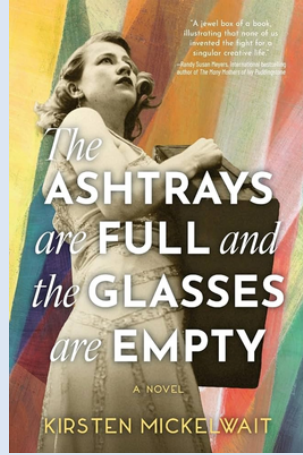

Forest Preserve Conservators

Plant of the Week – Northern Catalpa/Native & Japanese Lilac/non-native

Each flowering plant has its own period to flower. The different timing helps support our pollinators throughout the year. Trees also flower at different times. This week the last of our flowering trees and shrubs are completing their annual display.

Japanese Lilac - Everyone recognizes Common Lilacs, with their fragrant purple, pink, or white flowers. They grow to 10-12' tall. You may also recognize its smaller cousin, French Lilacs. However, fewer people recognize the last flowering small tree/large shrub of spring, which also is a lilac. As the name suggests, Japanese Lilacs originated in Japan. There are other varieties of lilacs, but the Japanese version is the largest one you will commonly see in our area. They can grow as large as 30' tall and 20' wide, and the profusion of tiny white flowers seem to almost dwarf its leaves while they are in bloom.



Northern Catalpa - The last native tree to flower at LBS is the Northern Catalpa. The one pictured here can be found on the route 59 side of Old Barn Road, between the entrances to Pine Crest Circle. It has just a few flowers left. Most Catalpas at LBS are found in the forest preserve. When Catalpas are at the height of their flowering, you can see many tall examples south of Miller Road, particularly along route 59.

The Northern Catalpa is the northernmost example of the bignonia family. Besides its late spring profusion of white flowers with yellow streaks and purple spots, the Catalpa is notable for several other distinctive features. Its heart-shaped leaves are larger than any other native tree in Illinois. They can be as much as 12" long. They also are noted for eye catching seedpods, that can be 10-20" long. The pods give it nicknames, such as the cigar tree, or Indian bean-tree. However, the seeds are not what we would call beans. Rather, each pod produces many ¾ to 1-1/8" long, hair-tipped seeds with papery wings. When the pods open the seeds can fly some distance, which helps them spread more widely. Few Catalpas are found in the residential area. Its wood is weak and breaks easily, and the leaves and seed pods can be messy. Catalpa wood does not have many uses, but it can be used for fence posts and telephone poles because it is slow to rot in soil.

In other news, many of you no doubt love to feed the hummingbirds that grace our community. It is really easy. They are plentiful and do regular swings through the neighborhood

checking feeders. It is said that every 9 cubic feet of space in the U.S. has been investigated by a hummingbird, so if you haven't seen one yet don't give up! Get yourself an inexpensive feeder - the one pictured is the best and easiest to keep clean. They are about \$12 or so at Ace Hardware and Home Depot. There are many beautiful feeders for sale but make sure it is one you can easily and thoroughly clean because that's important as bacteria and mold can build up and kill hummers. Here is a chart of how frequently your feeder should be cleaned and refilled (from Citizens for Conservation). And don't pay for premixed or red food mix. The best is to make it fresh with 8 oz boiling water, mix in 1/4 c granulated WHITE sugar (no brown, powdered or raw sugar as these be deadly) until it's fully dissolved, let it cool and pour it into your feeder. They often come around in the evening so relax and watch!

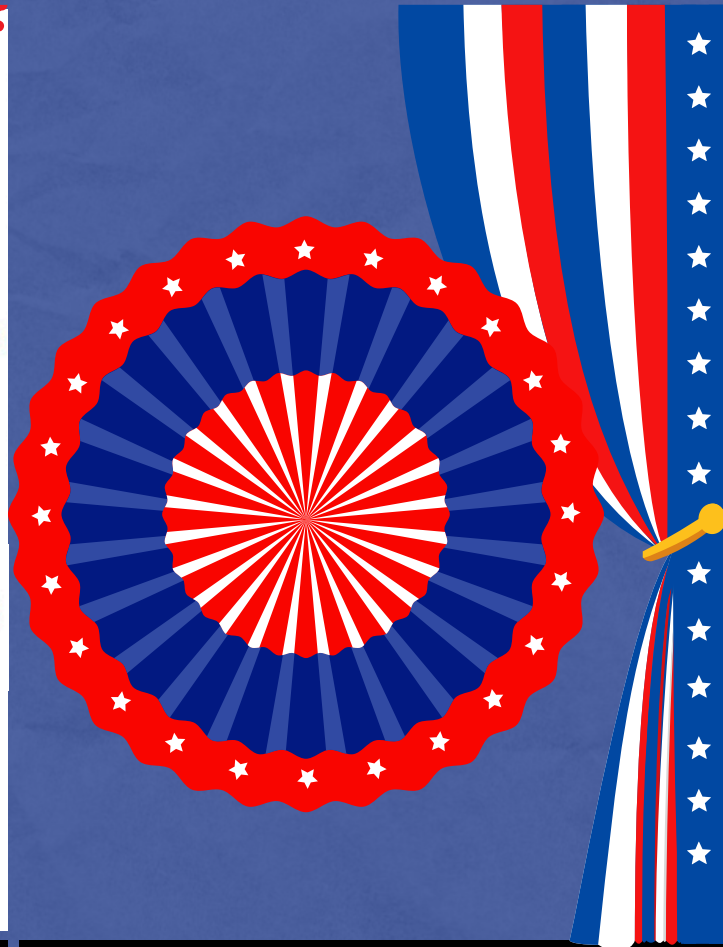

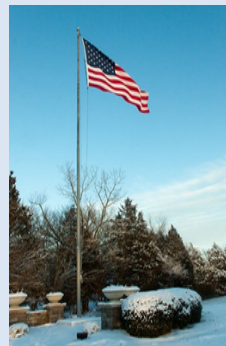
