You already know walking is good for you. But did you know that people who walk with an animal are more likely to meet physical activity recommendations? LBS residents and their guests are encouraged to come walk (with or without your pet) and we'll be joined by our friends at Soul Harbor Ranch and their mini therapy horses and therapy dogs. The little guys will accompany us on our walk to get their daily exercise!

Meet at Marina Rooftop. 30 minute walk followed by 30 minute social. Weather Permitting. No sign-up required.

**The SOUL Harbour Ranch Animal Therapy Program (501(c)3) offers Animal-Assisted Interventions (fun activity, therapy and educational visits and programs) within the Barrington and surrounding communities with their registered mini therapy horses, mini therapy donkeys and therapy dogs. They visit nursing homes, homes for the disabled, community outings and even hospitals!

OUTDOOR POOL

The Outdoor Pool is open daily from 4:30am - 9:00pm.

The Outdoor Pool is NOT guarded by lifeguards and is SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK.

- You **are required** to show a valid LBS ID card to access the outdoor pool. **Those without a LBS ID card will be turned away.**
- Guests **are required** be accompanied by LBS residents. **Guests may not use a resident's ID card, they will be turned away.**
- Children under age 16 **are required** to have an adult with them for the entire duration of their time at the pool.
- No food or drinks (other than water) are allowed on the pool deck. You may utilize the patio adjacent to the pool for eating and drinking.
- Guests are permitted to bring 4 guests each time they visit the pool. In addition to the 4 guests you are allocated 10 additional guest passes to be used throughout the year. These can be accessed when you check in with the pool attendant.
- Floats are not permitted at the pool, with the exception of personal floatation devices and "noodle" type floating devices.
- For a complete list of pool rules please see pages 33 - 36 in the rule book.

MARINA AND BEACH

The Marina is staffed Monday - Friday from 12:00pm - 8:00pm and

Saturdays / Sundays / Holidays from 10:00am - 8:00pm

The Lake is NOT guarded by lifeguards and is SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK

- You may check out a row boat or kayak at the Main Gate between sunrise - 12:00pm (weekdays) and sunrise - 10:00am (weekends and holidays). You will need your LBS ID card.
- Free Rides are offered on the Pontoon Boat Monday - Friday at 1:00pm and 2:00pm and on weekends / holidays at 11:00am, 12:00pm, 1:00pm, and 2:00pm. This schedule may be adjusted on Sundays when a Sailing Race is scheduled. All Sailing Races will be listed on the monthly calendar included in "The Shores Weekly".
- All swimmers must swim in the designated swim area.
- Fishing should only be done from the pier side and is not permitted from the beach side
- No Dogs Allowed at the Beach
- For a complete list of marina / beach rules please see pages 38-43 in the rule book.

Beach Party Guidelines

- Only one beach party can be booked per day. Parties can never take over the entire beach. There will be a maximum of 35 people per party.
- Three picnic tables and one of the grills are included with your beach rental.
- The Beach must be kept clean. Final cleanup must have all waste contained in plastic bags and deposited in the proper receptacle provided.
- A refundable deposit of \$100 is required at time of sign-up. Should additional cleanup be required, those costs will be taken from that deposit. Any unused remaining balance will be refunded, and any costs above \$100 will be assessed to the unit owner's account.

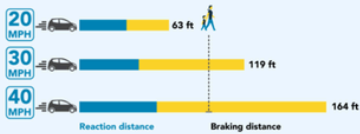

In our modern and globalized world, our actions often affect wildlife in unintended harmful ways and cause habitats to become more fragile. Feeding wildlife is no exception.

Below are some common negative consequences of feeding wildlife:

- 1** Increased road strikes
- 2** Changes in population dynamics and a reduction in biodiversity
- 3** Increased risk of health issues and disease transfer
- 4** Increased numbers of small predators like raccoons
- 5** Desensitization to humans
- 6** Introduction of invasive species

Please remember, fed is dead.

Do not feed wildlife. Create habitat instead.

THE PROBLEM WITH BISHOP'S WEED

Most LBS residents are familiar with Bishop's Weed (Aegopodium) — a widespread groundcover found throughout our community that many people find attractive. With its pale green, white-edged leaves, it's sometimes referred to as "Snow-on-the-Mountain."

Sounds lovely, doesn't it? But don't be fooled.

Bishop's Weed is an extremely invasive — and very tenacious — groundcover that can quickly choke out more desirable plants once it becomes established.

The wet start to this year's growing season created ideal conditions for its spread. As a result, Bishop's Weed has become a significant landscaping challenge for our community... and one that will not be easy to resolve.

Here's why:

- Once established, Bishop's Weed is very difficult to eliminate.
- It spreads aggressively through underground runners that extend in all directions, becoming intertwined with the roots of nearby plants.
- Simply pulling it is largely ineffective because it is nearly impossible to remove its dense and extensive root system completely. Even small root fragments can produce new growth and quickly reestablish dominance in planting beds.

The most effective method of removal is repeated application of a glyphosate herbicide (such as RoundUp). Unfortunately, this often requires multiple treatments over a period of weeks, and glyphosate-based herbicides kill virtually all vegetation they contact — not just Bishop's Weed.

In addition, repeated herbicide use can negatively impact the soil ecosystem that supports healthy plant growth. In short, eliminating Bishop's Weed is difficult, expensive, and environmentally problematic.

You can help by submitting a Landscape Variance Application before introducing new plants into the beds around your home.

And when shopping for groundcover, avoid plants described as "vigorous growers" or those that "fill in problem spots quickly." Many plants marketed this way are aggressive, invasive species that can create serious landscaping problems over time.

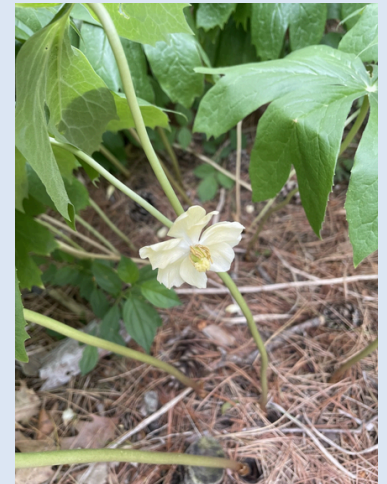

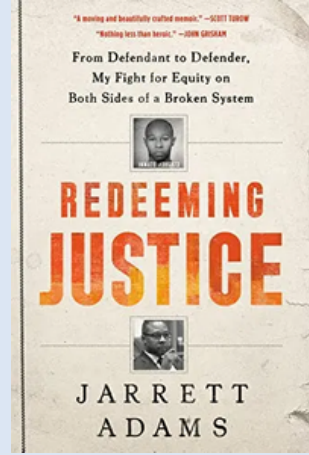
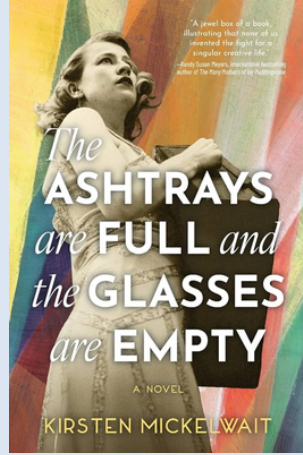

WARBLERS, WARBLERS everywhere!

We have documented 99 species of birds since 2019 here at LBS! This year we have seen more warblers and other spring migrating birds in our preserve than ever before! Below are photos of just a few (courtesy Bob Reynolds)

They may be a little hard to find in the preserve but your best chance is to go early in the morning, bring binoculars and be still. Look for movement in the trees and grasses. The Scarlet Tanager roosts in trees along the main/asphalt path in the woods at the top of the hill about midway from Old Barn to the end of the path. He is easy to spot because of his beautiful bright red color!

Forest Preserve Conservators

Plant of the Week – Virginia Stickseed/Native, but....

Some plants are native but a nuisance and are considered invasive. An example is Virginia Stickseed. If you have spent any time in the woods later in the year have experienced stickseed. It is the plant that makes the burs that stick to your clothing like Velcro. Usually in large numbers and which are difficult to remove. The Conservators work to either pull stickseed or spray it with herbicide, while we are treating other invasive plants, such as regrowth of buckthorn and honeysuckle.

Stickseed is an example of a plant that has evolved in a very specific way that allows it to thrive. In the spring stickseed starts as a short, innocuous looking plant. However, as the growing season advances, it becomes tall and spindly with long branches. Small white flowers grow on the branches, which turn into the dreaded burs. The plant evolved into a tall spindly plant to maximize its spread. When we, and furry animals like deer, brush against it the burs/stickseeds take a ride. Eventually they fall off and if they land in a favorable spot they will sprout, often far from the parent plant.

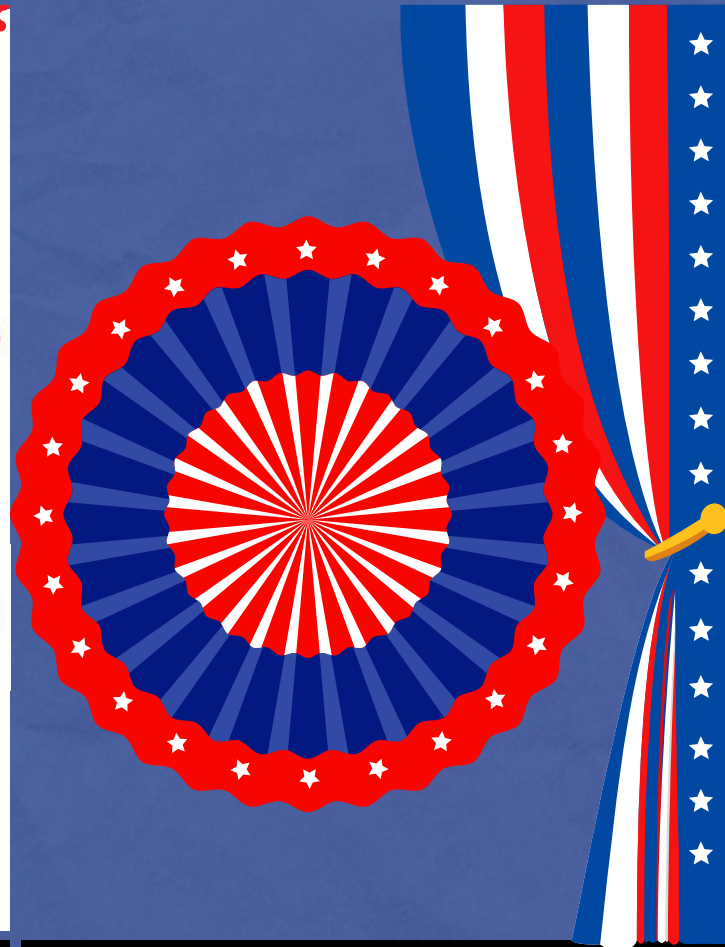

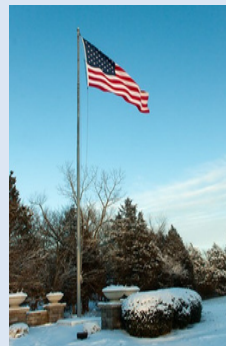


